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## Minimal consumer basket in Montenegro

## The first quarter (January to March) 2023

The total value of minimal consumer basket for January 2023 was 803.3 EUR, for February 809.4 EUR, and for March 801.1 EUR.

Minimal consumer basket for March 2023 compared with March 2022 increased 12.0%.

The expenditure on food and non-alcoholic beverages for March 2023 compared with March 2022, increased 16.0%, while the expenditure on non-food products and services, compared with March 2022 increased 8.6%.

Chart 1. Minimal consumer basket, January to March 2023 in EUR




## **METHODOLOGICAL NOTES**

The minimal consumer basket refers to the household consumptions, including food and non-food products and services of four-member household defined by the amount of calories per person, adequate to meet the energy needs for maintaining a healthy life and carrying out light physical activity. Defined calories are in accordance with minimum energy requirements of the World Health Organization (WHO) and the Food Guide of the United States Department of Agriculture in 2010 (USDA Food Guide 2010) of 2 211 Kcal per day, per person.

The minimal consumer basket is based on Household budget survey and recommendation of World Bank.

The total value of minimal consumer basket of fourmember household comprises minimum expenditures on food and non-food products and services. For calculating the value of minimum expenditure for food and non-alcoholic beverages, an average price in current months and quantity of products of four-member household are used. For calculating the value of non-food products, the consumer price indices (CPI) are used.

The deadlines for submission and publication of data are defined in the the Annual Plan of Statistical Surveys. In accordance with the Annual Plan of Statistical Surveys 2023 (Official Gazette of Montenegro, No. 5/2023 from 16 January 2023), the periodicity of data publication was changed from monthly to quarterly.
