INSTITUTIONS OF SOCIAL AND CHILD PROTECTION

The legal basis

The legal basis for the implementation of the survey Institutions of social and child protection is the Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System of Montenegro (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 18/12, 47/19 and 23/25) and Annual plan of statistical surveys.

METHODOLOGICAL GUIDELINES

Purpose of survey

Social and child protection is an activity that provides and implements measures and programs intended for individuals and families with unfavorable personal or family circumstances, which include prevention, assistance in meeting basic life needs and support. Social and child protection aims to improve the quality of life and empower individuals and families for independent and productive life.

The aim of research in the field of social protection institutions is to collect, process and publish data on users of accommodation services in social and child protection institutions.

Data sources and coverage

The data in this statistical survey were obtained from the Ministry of Social Welfare, Family Care and Demography of Montenegro, and refer to the average monthly number of beneficiaries of material support, personal disability allowance, care and support allowance and child support.

Data confidentiality

According to the Law on Official Statistics and the System of Official Statistics, reporting units are obliged to provide data in the required form. Individual data obtained through research are protected and used exclusively for statistical purposes.

Definitions

Institutions for children and youth without parental care are social institutions that provide care for children deprived of parental care and children whose development is hindered by family circumstances.

Institutions for children and youth with disabilities and developmental difficulties provide accommodation, care, health care, educational work and job training for children with mental disabilities.

Institutions for the care of adults and the elderly provide accommodation, complete care and health care, complete professional social and psychological assistance, legal and advisory assistance, assistance in administrative and financial matters concerning users, namely the elderly, disabled adults, chronically mentally ill elderly people, and people who find themselves in a state of acute social need.

Dissemination

The publication of data is done in accordance with the Statistical Release Calendar of the Statistical Office, according to a predefined date and manner of publishing data.

The published data are available to users in the form of statistical publication - Statistical yearbook.
