INTRODUCTION

Statistical office is an independent Montenegrin public administration body which provides, to all users, by using highest professional standards, quantitative and representative information's on economical, demographical, social movements and the situation of environment in Montenegro. The legal framework for production and dissemination of official statistics, as well as framework for organisation of system of official statistics of Montenegro, is defined with the law on official statistics and system of official statistics (Official gazette of Montenegro No. 18/12 dated on 30.03.2012)

Report on work of Statistical Office for previous year has been prepared according to Article 72 of the Law on Public Administration. Report is structured in a manner that users of statistical data and institutions, which monitor our work, provide an integrated overview of work of Statistical Office in one business year.

In 2013 Statistical office has conducted 184 regular surveys out of total 194, issued three publications, published 334 press releases, 1 newsletter, 9 statistical methodologies, held 6 press conferences, responded to 691 user request, participated on 87 international conferences, meetings, workshops, trainings or study visits outside of Montenegro, with the aim to improve official statistical system of Montenegro, as well as the work of 19 inter-institutional working groups.

Based on synthesis of results, which are shown in continuation of report, in 2013, we would like to highlight:

1. Defined legal framework of official statistical system trough legal acts:

- ✓ Program of official statistics for 2014 – 2018;
- ✓ Annual Plan of official statistics for 2014;
- ✓ Development strategy for official statistics in 2014 -2018.

For the purposes of middle term planning of development of official statistics, Program of official statistics for 2014-2018 has been made, based on elaborated notion of statistical product, and derived from its Annual Plan of Official Statistics, as short term document, which elaborates statistical activities to the level of statistical surveys. Official statistics development strategy 2014-2018 and Program of official statistics 2014-2018 are related to the same five year period, for which the Government of Montenegro has prepared a Program of accession of Montenegro to European Union. Therefore, the Strategy and Program of official statistics present detailed plan of harmonization of Chapter 18 – Statistics.

2. European integrations

In the June of 2013 Statistical office presented current status and planned activities of statistical system of Montenegro in the following period on Screening for Chapter 18 – Statistics, trough explanatory and bilateral meeting. Report from screening contains further guidelines for harmonization of Montenegrin statistical system with the European system.

Within the framework of Program of Accession of Montenegro defined are administrative, strategic, legal and financial frameworks, from the aspect of current status and future plans for period from 2014 till 2018. Making of the Program for Accession of Montenegro for Chapter 18, included the determination of relevance and competence for 1004 celexa, which were defined by European Commission and assigned them to Chapter 18. The acquis which is characteristic for chapter 18 has been evaluated in terms of competence and relevance, and all information's are entered into the Portal of European integration.

3. International activities

During the 2013 Statistical office has intensified cooperation with the United Nations Children fund – UNICEF, through project MICS 5 – Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey on rights of women and children in Montenegro, as well as on project Transformative tracking for improved equality – TransMONEE data base. Continued is cooperation with the UN Office for drugs and crime – UNODC, through the project of collecting the opinions and experiences of business entities, about safety and impact of criminal and corruption. Through international activities are developed partnership relations, which indirectly affect on integration of Montenegrin statistical system into European statistical system.

4. Inter-institutional cooperation

Statistical office has signed three agreements on cooperation with: (1) Ministry of agriculture and rural development of Montenegro, (2) University of Donja Gorica, (3) Montenegrin Employers Federation. By creating a good inter-institutional cooperation, developed is and expanded a network that improves development of official statistical system.

5. Internal documents

During the 2013 adopted are 4 internal documents that define organization, communication and management of statistical processes, which significantly increased efficiency and productivity in the work.

6. Education of personnel in EUROSTAT

Three employees of Statistical office have been on internship in EUROSTAT and National Statistical Institute of Hungary, for area: foreign trade statistics, international cooperation and migrations. Also, during the 2013th, 115 employees of Statistical office, and other official producers of statistics of Montenegro and relevant institutions of Montenegro, have participated in a total of 87 international working groups, trainings or study visits outside of Montenegro with the aim to improve official system of statistics in Montenegro.

1. LEGISLATIVE REGULATION AND OTHER REGULATIONS

The legislative framework of the official statistical system consists of the following legal acts:

1. Law on official statistics and system of official statistics¹;
2. Program of official statistics for 2014 – 2018;
3. Annual plan for official statistics for 2014;
4. Development strategy of official statistics 2014 – 2018;
5. Advance release calendar of statistical data for 2014;
6. Internal rules and guidelines of internal organization.

1.1 Adopted legal and other acts during the 2013.

1. **Program of official statistics 2014 – 2018** is an act which contains overview of statistical development objectives and activities, expected results and problems, periodicals of activity and level of compliance with European legislation. The act is processed and adopted by the Government of Montenegro on 23 January of 2014.
2. **Development strategy of official statistics 2014 – 2018** is an act that determines long-term goals on the basis of current condition and future development. The act is processed and adopted by the Government of Montenegro on 23 January of 2014.
3. **Annual plan for official statistics in 2014** is an act which elaborates statistical activities to the level of statistical survey. With annual plan envisaged are 211 surveys, that were included in six areas: (1) Demographic and social statistics; (2) Macroeconomic statistics; (3) Business statistics; (4) Statistics of agriculture, forestry and fishery; (5) Multi-domain statistics and (6) the area related to support for the statistical results. The act is processed and adopted by the Government of Montenegro on 23 January of 2014.
4. **Advance release calendar of statistical data for 2014 is document** which contains overview of surveys and dates of releases, when survey will become publicly available.
5. **Statistical office dissemination strategy** (No.01-1013 from 21.03.2013.), is a document that will make available, in a comprehensible way, to all users, statistical data in the same time and under the same condition. It is implemented through five strategic objectives: the creation of demand for the data from Statistical Office, data content availability, data transparency, distribution channels of data and communication with the users.

1. 1.2 INTERNAL RULES OF PROCEDURE AND INSTRUCTIONS

Following the adoption of Law on official statistics and system of official statistics, Statistical office has adopted a series of internal acts regulating internal organization, communication and management of statistical processes, in order to standardize working procedures and clearly identify competencies and responsibilities for each aspect of statistical process:

During the 2013 adopted are following procedures:

1. **Procedure for the translation of official documents**, (No. 01-1016 from 21.03.2013) is a document that defines the process of documents translation, responsibilities of interpreter and prioritizing of translation.
2. **The procedure for organizing and monitoring the effects of assessment missions**, (No.01-1019, from 21.03.2013) is a document that defines coordination of the data collection process for the preparation of the assessment mission and monitoring the implementation activities for the improvement, that are defined with assessment report.
3. **Handbook for writing of the terms of reference**, (No.01-1015 from 21.03.2013) is a document that defines the mode of writing the project terms of reference.
4. **Dress code for Statistical office employees**, (No. 01-1014 from 21.03.2013) defines set of dress codes for employees of Statistical office.

IMPLEMENTATION OF ANNUAL PLAN OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS FOR 2013

In competence of Statistical office are 194 statistical surveys, whose realization is planned in 2013, out of which 95% is realized and published, according to the Annual plan of surveys for 2013, while 5% of statistical surveys have not been realized.

2.1 Implemented statistical survey

Out of total number of implemented statistical surveys, in 2013, 184 were realized, out of which 11 are new:

1. **Pilot reports on milk and dairy products on monthly level** – with this report are collected data on entry of raw cow milk in dairies and milk products obtained with monthly periodicals collection;
2. **Pilot survey on number and capacities of waste treatment plants** – this survey provides data on number and capacities of waste treatment plants;
3. **Pilot survey on waste created in construction sector and service industries** – this survey provides data on types and quantities of waste they generate, internally processed and disposed by business subjects in area of construction and service industries;
4. **Pilot survey on collection and treatment of waste** – this survey provides data on quantities of collected or imported waste, processing methods, removal or export of waste;
5. **Survey for update of Statistical register of agricultural holdings (SRAH)** – update of SRAH with the external data bases;
6. **Pilot survey on businesses of enterprises that have units within** - this survey provides data on statistical unit – local unit, for which there is no administrative source. This survey has enabled additional harmonization with the EU Regulations (177/2008, 192/2009)
7. **Statistical survey of industry (PRODCOM²)** - this survey provides information on production of processing products in sectors B and C, classification of economic activity 2010. Survey is conducted on basis of PRODCOM list, which is updated every year by the EU;
8. **Statistical survey in area of other services** – this survey aims to follow and analyze scope, dynamics and structure of turnover in industrial production;
9. **Pilot survey on value of industrial production** – this survey aims to track the index of value of turnover in industrial production;
10. **Report on reloading in ports** – aim of the survey on reloading in maritime transport is to collect and process data on loading and unloading of goods that are achieved by enterprises from service industry in maritime transport;
11. **Pilot survey on freight road transport** – aim of the survey is analyze of data on travel, vehicles and goods transported by the legal/natural persons who are the owners/users of freight road vehicles/skidder with a transport capacity higher than 3500kg;
12. **The labour cost survey** – this survey provides data on labour cost and includes costs that the employer has on basis of engagement of labour force;
13. **Statistics on incomes and living conditions (EU SILC)** – the aim of this survey is to provide data on poverty, incomes, social exclusion of the population as well as other indicators (housing situation, current employment, financial component, etc.).

2.2 Non-realized statistical surveys

Out of total 194 planned statistical surveys, 9 statistical surveys were not realized in accordance with the Annual plan of statistical surveys for 2013.

One of the reasons for non-realization of planned statistical surveys is different time period of preparation of Annual plan of official statistics and plan of budget funds. Annual plan of official statistics is defined on the basis of planned budget funds in June of current year, but approved funds are always lesser than planned funds, and therefore it is not possible to completely realize defined Annual plan of official statistics.

Other reason for non-realization of statistical surveys financed through resources of IPA funds, is of administrative nature, due to cancelation or postponement of tender procedure.

Annual survey on implementation of supply and use table in calculation of gross domestic product (**pilot project**) – is not fully implemented because its implementation is envisaged through national project IPA 2010, which was late with the implementation due to administrative reasons (annulment of tender).
 2. **Calculation of quarterly gross domestic product by expenditure method (pilot project)** –the realization of this started but its implementation will continue through IPA national project;
 3. **Statistical survey on mobility of passengers (pilot survey)** – is not implemented due to lack of human resources during the 2013;
 4. **Report on the transport of passengers and goods by airport pairs (pilot survey)** – is not implemented due to lack of human resources during the 2013;
 5. **Survey on structure of agricultural holding** – is not implemented due to lack of human resources and not updating of Statistical register of agricultural holdings. Census of agriculture was conducted in 2010, and in 2012 Statistical register of agricultural holdings was established. In 2013, by signing of a Memorandum of cooperation with the Ministry of agriculture and rural development, created were the conditions for updating with the administrative sources.
 6. **Pilot survey on pesticides** – has not been realized due to lack of human resources during the 2013. In 2013 started cooperation with the Ministry of agriculture and rural development (Phytosanitary Administration) in accordance with signed Memorandum of cooperation, and created are conditions for the implementation of aforementioned pilot survey in 2014, and downloading data from administrative source.

7. **Survey on sport clubs** - has not been implemented because Directorate of Sports and Youth, as administrative source, was not able to deliver data, due to changes in program for data processing.
8. **Survey on social protection - ESSPROS (pilot survey)** is not implemented due to lack of human resources during the 2013;
9. **Survey on scientific research activity – research and development (IR-1) for 2012** – has not been implemented due to poor response of reporting units in 2013.

2.3 Methodological harmonization achieved in 2013

A. National accounts

In the first half of 2013 efforts were made to improve the annual GDP (gross domestic product) in constant prices, by experimental application of simplified framework of supply and use tables. Aim of this activity was related to the harmonization with the Commission Decision 98/715/EC, and the possibility of full implementation of double deflation method.

In third quarter of 2013, published were results of calculated annual gross domestic product (GDP) for 2012 by production and expenditure approach. The calculation was carried out in constant and current prices and it is in accordance with the classification of activity NACE Rev 2.

Experimental calculation of gross national income (GNI) of Montenegro for period 2010-2011 was done.

Available results of calculation were sent to EUROSTAT, via e-Damis within ESA 95 *Data transmission*, thus continued practice of transferring the available results of calculation.

Also, published are revised results of quarterly GDP for 2012 and preliminary results of GDP for first three quarters of 2013. Preliminary results of quarterly GDP may be revised up until the moment of publishing of results of annual GDP.

The calculations were carried out on production side, in current and constant prices by applying the indirect method and in accordance with the classification NACE Rev.2

For the needs of experimental calculation of quarterly GDP, by expenditure methods, taken are necessary steps in realization of this activity, in a manner that collected are available data and calculated individual components of GDP. Sources and methods, used for calculation of all expenditure categories on quarterly level, will be in accordance with the sources and methods that are used for calculation of annual GDP, by using consumption approach.

In order to improve calculation of quarterly GDP, by production method, collected are available data which are available as direct data sources, i.e. same sources that are used in annual calculation of GDP, but with the quarterly dynamics and they have been applied in calculation for certain activities in current prices.

Also, prepared were all available data that represent needed inputs for the compilation of supply and use tables, in order to continue in next period with realization of this activity.

B. Structural business statistic

Within the structural business statistics, compiled and processed are data on the operations of business entities for 2012, in accordance with methodology that relies on Regulation of European Commission No. 295/2008, which established a common framework for collection, processing and publishing of data on activities of enterprise. Published is an analysis "*Business of enterprises in Montenegro in 2012*" which contains main indicators of Montenegrin business, and according to different activities and classes of business entities.

C. Foreign Affiliates Statistics - FATS statistics

Within the FATS statistics (foreign affiliate's statistics) were developed two surveys:

- Survey of external statistics of foreign affiliates (OFATS statistics) which describes activity of affiliates abroad under the control of domestic economy and;
- Survey of internal statistics of foreign affiliates (IFATS statistics) which describes activity of domestic affiliates under the control of foreign economy.

Data on operations of foreign affiliates are collected and processed in accordance with the methodology, which relies on Regulation (EC) no. 716/2007 of European Parliament and Council (EC) 20th June 2007 on structure and activity of foreign affiliates.

D. Tourism statistics

Redesign of questionnaire was completed for survey on arrivals and overnight stays of tourists. New variable was introduced (total number of rented rooms) and its complied with the list of countries of origin of foreign tourists according to the Regulation of European Union no. 692/2011

E. Energy statistics

Improvement of energy statistics was accomplished in several segments: questionnaire on consumption of liquid fuels was prepared; data collecting on liquid fluids is done by web application EIS (energetic information system); for first time, in June of 2013, were sent to EUROSTAT data on coal on quarter level. Also, initiated are activities related to preparation of survey in the area of renewable energy.

F. Transport statistics

Improvement of transport statistics was accomplished by sending data to EUROSTAT, via e-DAMIS: annual data on railroad transport, annual data on traffic accidents in road transport and annual data on maritime transport.

G. Agriculture and environment

➤ Pilot report on milk and dairy products on monthly level

Designed questionnaire and prepared methodological instruction is in accordance with the directive (EC) no. 96/16. Collected are data on entry of raw cow milk in dairies and obtained dairy products with monthly collections periodicals.

Created are new methods for calculation of balance of entry of raw milk and obtained dairy products.

➤ **Survey on slaughter of stock and poultry in slaughterhouses**

Performed modification of questionnaire is in accordance with the Regulation (EC) no. 1165/2008 (section II, Annex IV) and harmonized methodology. Changed is the periodic of collecting of data from quarterly to monthly dynamics. Collected are data on the number and weight of slaughtered livestock by types and categories.

➤ **Annual survey on cattle breeding of agricultural holdings – A survey on number of livestock**

Performed modification of questionnaire is in accordance with the Regulation (EC) no. 1165/2008 (Annex IV) and harmonized methodology. Collected are data on the number of livestock by types and categories of livestock, weights of livestock, balances of livestock, poultry, milk and eggs, as well as data on the number of beehives, production of wool, eggs, honey and dairy products.

➤ **Pilot survey on the number and capacities of waste treatment plants**

Designed questionnaire and prepared instruction for completing of the questionnaire are in accordance with the Commission Regulation (EU) no. 849/2010 on changes of the Regulation (EC) no. 2150/2002 of European parliament and Council on waste statistics. Collected are data on the number and capacities of waste treatment plants.

➤ **Pilot survey on waste created in construction sector and service industries**

Designed questionnaire and prepared instruction for completing of the questionnaire are in accordance with the Commission Regulation (EU) no. 849/2010 on changes of the Regulation (EC) no. 2150/2002 of European parliament and Council on waste statistics. Collected are data on the types and quantities of waste they generate, internally process and dispose business entities from construction sector and service industries. Created is software application for data processing.

➤ **Pilot survey on collection and treatment of waste**

Designed questionnaire and prepared instruction for completing of the questionnaire are in accordance with the Commission Regulation (EU) no. 849/2010 on changes of the Regulation (EC) no. 2150/2002 of European parliament and Council on waste statistics. Collected are data on quantities of collected or imported waste, processing methods, removal or export of waste. Software application for data processing is created.

H. Business register

➤ **Survey for updating on Statistical register of agricultural holdings (SRAH) – updating of SRAH with the external data bases**

Questionnaire is designed and methodological instruction, for updating of data in Statistical register of agricultural holdings with the data from administrative sources, are according to the Law on official statistics and statistical system "Official gazette of Montenegro, no. 18/12". Collected are identification data of agricultural holdings that are not in the Statistical register of agricultural holdings. For newly created holdings collected are data on cattle breeding and crop production.

➤ **Survey on business of small and medium enterprises**

Completed modification of questionnaire and methodology harmonized. Collected is identification, financial and demographical data on medium and large enterprises, in order to update Statistical business register and create statistical unit Group of enterprises.

➤ **Pilot survey on business of enterprises that have units within**

Questionnaire is designed, methodological instruction are prepared in accordance with the EU Regulations (177/2008, 192/2009), and software application for data entry is created. Data are collected on enterprises that have units within, with the aim to obtain data for creation of statistical unit – local unit.

- **For the first time was prepared report on quality of Business register**, based on seven criteria of European Statistics code of practice, namely: Relevance, Accuracy, Timeliness, Accessibility and clarity of registry documentation, Coherency, Good Methodology and Statistical Confidentiality.

I. Annual survey on use of information and communication technologies in households and enterprises

Questionnaire was revised due to introduction of new features in individual modules, thereby achieving compliance with the Regulation (EU) no. 1083/2012.

J. Labour force survey

In 2013 were published results of ad hoc module on employees and health problems, which was conducted in IV quarter of 2012. During the 2013 bases were sent for I and II quarter of 2010th to EUROSTAT via e-DAMIS and validation of obtained data was performed. Revision of features was performed on highest level of education completed with new modalities (new system of education – Bologna Declaration).

K. Household budget survey

Harmonization with the COICOP classification has been preformed, i.e. classification of personal consumption by purpose on quarterly level was made

L. Statistics on income and living conditions (EU SILC)

Methodology was made, questionnaires designed, sample instruction for the interviewers were designed, and program for entry was made, as well as application for the logic – computational control.

2.4 Dissemination of data and public relations

In 2013 printed and published were three publications that are substantially enriched in regard to previous editions, and supplemented with graphical representations.

Published are 334 press releases (monthly, quarterly and annual). Issued press releases are improved in design, graphics and content. Availability of data on official site is increased, because of translation of all contents into English language.

2.4.1 Public relations

During the 2013 Statistical Office held a total of 6 press conferences.

- In February of 2013 Statistical office has, in cooperation with the project “Development of forestry in Montenegro” – FODEMO, held press conference on the occasion of presentation of results on consumption of wood fuel in 2011 in Montenegro. On the conference was presented prepared publication entitled “*Consumption of wood fuels in 2011 in Montenegro*”.
- In cooperation with the United Nations Children Fund – UNICEF – Statistical office March of 2013 held press conference on the occasion of start of implementation of *MICS 5 Survey – Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey on rights of women and children in Montenegro*.
- In July of 2013 press conference was held on the occasion of publishing the results of “*Gross domestic product for I quarter of 2013*”.
- Press conference on the occasion of publishing the results of “*Gross domestic product for 2012*” and “*Gross domestic product for II quarter of 2013*” was held in September of 2013.
- Results of “*Gross domestic product for III quarter of 2013*” and results of “*Labour force survey and unemployment rate for the III quarter of 2013*” were published at the press conference, which was held in December of 2013.
- Statistical office has in cooperation with the UN Office on Drugs and Crime – UNODS held press conference in December of 2013, on the occasion of the presentation of the “*Report on corruption and criminal amongst private business entities in Montenegro*”.

On the official mail of Statistical office during the 2013 was sent total of 691 user request. Out of the total number of request, 605 was related to requests on data and information’s from the external institutions, while 86 requests was sent by the media houses, on which Statistical office answered.

Requests according to frequency were directed towards the following areas or departments in Statistical office and are shown in table 3:

In September of 2013, Statistical office has participated in professional conference, in Montenegro: "*Miločer Development Forum*" organized by Association of economist of Montenegro, on the panel "*History of Economic Thought in Montenegro: the idea of the origin and development of Plantations*".

2.5 Other development activities (IT activities)

2.5.1 Technical conditions

1. In the order to protect and preserve data realized is the installation of backup server.
2. Continued with the daily updating of the website.
3. Continued with the work on maintenance of informational communicational technologies, that is used as support to development of the statistical system

2.5.2 Programming

In 2013 Statistical office simplified the representation of data on official website, which facilitated access to the users of official statistics data.

During the 2013 following changes/improvements were made in existing applications.

. INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND INTEGRATION IN INTERNATIONAL STATISTICAL SYSTEM

4.1 European integrations

In the process of European integrations Statistical office has a dual role:

:

- Harmonization of Chapter 18 – Statistics with the European Union legislation
- To provide statistical data and information's to other relevant Chapters in process of European integrations

Within its first role, and regarding the preparation for Screening and harmonization to Chapter 18 – Statistics with the European legislation, Statistical office, has in period from January till June of 2013, based on self-assessment of harmonization of statistics which included following activities, carried out: (1) study of European legislation from area of statistics, (2) an assessment of current situation in relation to European legislation, (3) preparation of harmonization plans, prepared presentations for bilateral screening, as well non paper³ with the description of current situation and planned activities.

At screening for Chapter 18 – Statistics, in June 2013 official producers of statistics have presented current situation and planned activities of statistical system of Montenegro. Report from the screening of Chapter 18 contains further guidelines and recommendations for harmonization with European legislation.

Within the Accession program of Montenegro to European Union, for period 2014-2018 Statistical office has defined administrative, strategic, legislative and financial frameworks from aspect of current situation and future plans for period from 2014 till 2018. Making of the program for Montenegro's accession, for Chapter 18, included determination of relevance for 1004 celexa, defined by the European Commission and assigned it to chapter 18. The acquis, which is characteristic for chapter 18, was evaluated from aspect of competence and relevance, and all information's are entered into the Portal of European integrations.

As a part of its other role, employees of Statistical office were participants in working groups of other relevant Chapters. In order to define responsibilities and work activities, way of communication and data delivery of data from Statistical office within the relevant working groups, respected were guidelines defined in internal document "*Instruction on the participation of Statistical office in work of working groups and other negotiation chapters*" (no. 01-3551 from 27.11.2012).

Statistical office is a member of the total 14 working groups of other negotiation Chapters:

4.2 Integration into the international statistical systems

Statistical office in regular periodic delivers to EUROSTAT, via eDAMIS portal and eDAMIS web application data from 22 domains (agricultural census, livestock breeding, foreign trade, statistics of the judiciary, demography statistics, national accounts, HICP, labour force survey, migrations, Purchasing Power Parities, construction, tourism, statistics of information society, energetic, trade, data from statistical business register, household budget survey, PRODCOM, railway transport statistics, road transport statistics, crop production, dairy products).

In relation to 2012 increased is the volume of data sent for 4 statistical areas (statistics of railway transport, road transport statistics, crop production, dairy products).

Performed was updating of the metadata within General dissemination system of International Monetary Fund (GDDS-IMF), which is in line with IMF Instruction. In order for pre-preparation for start of negotiations for membership in Special dissemination system of IMF (SDDS-IMF), and in accordance with recommendations from experts, prepared was List of indicators (National Summary Data Page – NSDP) and Calendar with the data (Advance release calendar – ARC) which is updated on monthly basis and published on the official website of Statistical office.

4.3 International projects

During 2013 a total of 115 employees from Statistical office and other relevant institutions of Montenegro participated on total of 87 international conferences, meetings, workshops, trainings or study visits outside of Montenegro, in order to improve official statistical system of Montenegro.

IPA 2011 multi-beneficiary:

- 82 horizontal activities (a total of 115 employees)

a) IPA 2010 National project

IPA 2010 National project officially started in May 2013. Inception report (Introduction report) was accepted and realization of planned activities is going as planned. Also, first Interim progress report (first semi-annual report), which includes first six months of project realization, is approved by the project steering committee.

b) Programming of IPA 2012-2013 National project

In July of 2012 was launched process of verification of proposal for project IPA 2012-2013 of national projects for Montenegro. Although Statistical office was included from the very programming of project Sector Identification Fiche - SIF –“*Public administration reform*”, after the comments from relevant directorates of projects of European Commission, the project “*Strengthening statistical capacity building and provision of economic and social statistics*”, in cooperation with the Ministry of science, was placed as Project Identification Fiche – PIF (separate project). Key components of the project are: macroeconomic statistics, business statistics and social statistics. Start of this project is forecasted for second quarter of 2015.

c) IPA 2011 multi beneficiary project

IPA 2011 multi beneficiary project started on July 2012, and lasts for 24 months. This project covers 14 pilot projects, as follows:

1. Methodology of national accounts
2. Quarterly national accounts
3. Agro-monetary statistics
4. Annual statistics of crop production
5. Animal production statistics
6. Water statistics
7. Waste statistics
8. Incomes and living conditions
9. Household budget survey

All activities related for stated pilot projects were realized according to defined project plan. During the 2013, on overall of 82 activities, 115 employees from Statistical office participated. Out of that number 80 participants attended working groups (68), 20 participants of the workshops (11) and 15 participants on trainings (2).

Within the same project, during the 2013, was held 16 expert missions.

Three employees from Statistical office, within this project, were on internship in EUROSTAT (2) and in National Statistical Institute of Hungary (1).

d) IPA 2012 multi beneficiary project

IPA 2012 multi beneficiary project started on December of 2013 and includes 11 pilot projects:

1. Methodology of national accounts;
2. Agro-monetary statistics;
3. The annual crop statistics;
4. Livestock breeding statistics;

Planned duration of project is to a 30th November of 2015.

e) Projects financed by the United Nations – UN

➤ International monetary fund (IMF)

IMF's statistical department (STA) has launched a three-year project 2012-2014 – *Capacity building for sustainable development of statistics in the real sector in Eastern Europe*, financed by the Government of Japan, through administrative accounts for selected IMF activities. Main cause of the project is to assist the nine countries of South East Europe, to improve accuracy of estimates of national accounts and prices. Project is supported by the three long term experts in the real sector, and consists of few workshops and missions which will be conducted in period of three years.

Statistical office has during the 2013 hosted two missions, 18 and 19 March and 4 and 11 September, in which participated employees from department of national accounts, as well as representatives of Central bank of Montenegro.

f) Projects in cooperation with the UNICEF

Statistical office has, in cooperation with the UNICEF, started to work on the *Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey on rights of women and children in Montenegro MICS 5*, international household survey program developed by the UNICEF, in duration from October 2012 till the December of 2013.

Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey, on rights of women and children in Montenegro MICS 5, provides data that are related on the status of children and women, as well as key indicators which monitor the development towards the Millennium Development Goals and other national and international strategies.

In project *TransMONEE data base* (Transformative monitoring for improved equality) Statistical office coordinates collecting of data for regular annual update of TransMONEE data base

Stated data base includes range of data important for social and economical issues important for the status and well-being of children, youth and women on level CEE/CIS (countries of Central and East Europe and Commonwealth of Independent States).

Data collection is done on inter-institutional level, which includes following institutions: Statistical office, Ministry of work and social welfare of Montenegro, Institute of public health of Montenegro, Montenegro Police Directorate, Institute for Execution of Criminal Sanctions, Pension and Disability Insurance Fund of Montenegro, Public Health Institution Special Hospital for pulmonary disease "Dr Jovan Bulajić" Brezovik, Employment agency of Montenegro and Women's Safe House.

Within the project *TransMONEE database* regularly is prepared analytical report. This year's analytical report is prepared on subject "Measuring Disability Prevalence". Analytical report was prepared by the working group whose participants are: Statistical office, Ministry of work and social welfare of Montenegro and Institute for Strategic Studies and Prognosis.

a) **Projects in cooperation with the UN office on Drugs and Crime - UNODC**

Statistical office has in cooperation with the UN office on drugs and crime – UNODC conducted survey on safety and criminal over the business entities in Montenegro.

The survey is a part of the project of United Nations in aim of collecting the opinions and experiences of business entities on safety and impact of criminal and corruption.

Result of project is publication "*Corruption and criminal amongst private business entities in Montenegro*" which was presented at a conference organized by Statistical office on 20th December 2013, and published on the official website of Statistical office.

5. EXTERNAL AUDIT AND CONTROL

During the 2013 Statistical office had one inspection control in conduction of public procurement procedures. With the insight of inspection control in conducted public procurement procedures in 16 concluded contracts, it was noted that contracts were concluded and published in accordance with the provisions of Law on public procurements. Contracts were timely and in envisaged deadlines delivered to competent authority, and the business is conducted in accordance with the Montenegrin regulations and legislation.

6. FINANCES AND HUMAN RESOURCES

6.1 Financial resources

In 2013 to Statistical office were approved budget resources in the amount of 1, 64 mil. € expressed in three programs: Program of statistical surveys, analyzes and informing, Administration program and Program of census of population, households and dwellings in 2011.

Implemented regular budget assets in 2013 amounted 1, 39 mil. €, or 85% of the total approved budget assets.

In public procurement plan (no.01-228/3 dated 23.01.2013) is planned realization of public procurements in value of 182.354,00 €, which was increased by the value of travel agencies services – flight tickets, which carried out amendment changes of Plan of public procurements (no.01-2252 dated 11.07.2013) so planned realization of public procurements amounted 196.354,00 €. The reason for change in Plan of public procurements is attendance of representatives from Statistical office on screening meetings in June 2013.

During 2013 realized were total 11 procurements with shopping method, and 5 open public procurement procedures.

Conducted public procurements during 2013 amounted to a total of: 176.525,6 4€ or 90% of the total planned.

Realized savings

Realized savings, as difference between evaluated and contracted value by shopping method, amounted 3.858,44 €, while at open public procurement procedures realized savings were in amount of 4.467,87 €, which represents a total savings of 8.326,31 €, in public procurement procedures.

6.2 Human resources

The total number of employees at the end of 2013 is 104 employees, and in comparison with the 2012 number of employees at the end of 2013 was lower by 4, 8% or 5 employees.
