SUMMARY

The key results in 2015 that contributed to the implementation of strategic aims defined by the Programme and Development Strategy of Official Statistics 2014-2018 are summarized here:

1. For the purpose of harmonizing official statistics of Montenegro with the EU acquis communautaire concerning the official statistics:

- Secondary legislation adopted: Annual plan of official statistics for 2016 (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 71/15), and amendments to the Programme of Official Statistics 2014 – 2018 (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 71/15);
- Statistical Office carried out 189 (99%) statistical surveys out of a total of 192 surveys planned by Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015; 6 publications issued; 282 press releases published; 2 analyses; 18 methodological guidelines; 5 press conference held, 630 users' requests responded;
 - Harmonizing statistical methodology with the EU standards achieved in the following domains: macro-economic statistics and National Accounts; agriculture i environment; business statistics - tourism, energy, industry, construction, transport; living conditions and household consumption statistics, and 2 statistical classifications implemented;
- A significant progress has been made with the fulfilment of benchmarks in Chapter 18- Statistics (ESA 2010), with publication of annual GDP in accordance with ESA 2010 and quarterly GDP in accordance with ESA 2010 methodology. Additionally, a new macroeconomic aggregate Gross National Income has been published for the first time.

2. For the purpose of strengthening administrative capacities and staff education:

- Higher management staff in Statistical Office strengthened by the appointment of two assistant directors;
- Education/traineeship in EUROSTAT, duration of 4-6 months, 4 staff members;
- Education and presence in total 145 international conferences, meetings, workshops, trainings or study visits out of Montenegro to improve the official statistical system of Montenegro, via IPA multi-beneficiary programme has been provided for staff members of Statistical Office and other producers of official statistics.

3. For the purpose of increased use of administrative sources for needs of official statistics:

- 6 memoranda agreement signed with holders of administrative records aimed at reduction of burden on reporting units and reducing costs;
- The Government of Montenegro has adopted the Information on Importance and Use of Administrative Data Sourced for Statistical Purposes, aimed at drawing attention to the importance of administrative data use when producing official statistics, in this particular case, Population Census planned to be conducted in 2021.

4. For the purpose of improving statistical processes by introduction of new technologies:

- Two new methods in data collection developed: CAWI method (data collection via web or e-questionnaire), and CAPI method (data collection with use of laptop, netbook, etc.);
- Strategy of Statistical Office for ICT development defined.

Montenegro 2015 Progress Report, pursuant to new methodology Chapter 18 - Statistics has received an assessment "some progress" and "some level of preparation", along with recommendation to considerably strengthen human and financial resources, and further align its statistics with ESA 2010, including government finance statistics.

1. LEGISLATION OF OFFICIAL STATISTICAL SYSTEM

Legislative framework of official statistical system is consisted of the following legal acts:

1. Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System of Montenegro (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 18/12);
2. Programme of Official Statistics 2014-2018 (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 13/14, its amendments (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 71/15);
3. Development Strategy of Official Statistics 2014-2018 (Government of Montenegro adopted it on 23 January 2014);
4. Annual plan of official statistics for 2016 (Official Gazette of Montenegro No71/14 od 17.12.2015);
5. Rulebook on Internal Organization and Job Descriptions (adopted by the Government of Montenegro on 4 September 2014), and
6. Calendar of Publishing Statistical Data for 2016 of Statistical Office and Other Producers of Official Statistics.

1.1 Adopted legislative and other acts in 2015

1. Pursuant to Article 21 paragraph 3 of the Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 18/12), Government of Montenegro, at its 131st session held on 15 October 2015, adopted the Decision **on Amendments to the Programme of Official Statistics 2014 – 2018**. Programme of Official Statistics 2014–2018 represents a framework for development, production and dissemination of official statistics of Montenegro, for period of five years. All priority activities of official statistics are summarized and incorporated in this document adopted in accordance with Development strategy of official statistics.
The reason of amendments to the Programme of official statistics 2014-2018 is the accession of Ministry of Science to the system of Montenegrin official statistics. Ministry of Science fulfilled all conditions for the accession to the system of Montenegrin official statistics in the area of R&D statistics, pursuant to Article 7 of the Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System, and Procedure on accession of statistical producer in Montenegro official statistical system (No 01-293 from 9 February 2015).
2. **Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2016** envisages the implementation of 212 statistical activities. Out of total number of planned statistical surveys, there are 160 statistical surveys (75%) that are to be conducted by Statistical Office, as the main coordinator and disseminator of statistical data, while 52 statistical surveys (25%) are to be conducted by other official statistical producers. Annual plan is based on user demands and Five-year Programme of Official Statistics as well as demands of the European Union, provided in the document of Eurostat *Statistical Requirements Compendium*.
3. **Calendar of publishing statistical data for 2016 of Statistical Office and other producers of official statistics** represents the overview of statistical surveys and a publication about dynamics, contents, and format of publishing statistical surveys and publications.
4. **Information on use of administrative sources for statistical purposes** (adopted at the 139th session of the Government of Montenegro from 10 December 2015) aims at drawing the attention on the importance of use of administrative data when producing the results of official statistics, in this concrete case Montenegro Population Census, planned to be conducted in 2021.

2. IMPLEMENTATION OF ANNUAL PLAN OF OFFICIAL STATISTICS FOR 2015

Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015 is prepared in accordance with Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 18/12 of 30 March 2012).

Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015 envisages 237 statistical surveys in total.

The number of statistical surveys conducted by Statistical Office, as the main coordinator and disseminator of statistical data, organizer and coordinator of official statistics is 192 statistical surveys (81%), while other official statistical producers conducted 45 statistical surveys (19%).

2.1 Implementation of Annual plan of official statistics for 2015 under competence of Statistical Office

Statistical Office is the main coordinator and disseminator of statistical data as well as responsible, expert coordinator, organizer, and coordinator of official statistical system of Montenegro that carries out the majority of statistical surveys. Of 192 statistical surveys planned in total, Statistical Office carried out 189 surveys or 99% out of which there are 12 new ones:

1. Harmonized index of consumer prices in administrative prices – pilot survey;
2. Harmonized index of consumer prices in constant tax rates- pilot survey;
3. Classification of institutional units by institutional sectors for total economy.
Statistical Office worked on the preparation of draft classification of institutional units by institutional sectors in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology. It is necessary to prepare and harmonize the classification of institutional units by institutional sectors in accordance with international methodology and recommendations, what is planned during 2016, in cooperation with Ministry of Finance, Central Bank of Montenegro;
4. Calculation of quarterly gross domestic product by production and consumption method using direct approach- pilot survey;
5. Analysis of government finance statistics - pilot survey;
6. Survey on structure of income and intermediary consumption by activities (SPIR), envisaged by Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015, and conducted on the field at the end of 2014. During 2015 there were performed entering, number and logical data control. The results of survey SPIR are used for producing of supply and use table ;

7. Annual survey on the implementation of supply and use table in the calculation of gross domestic product - pilot survey;
8. Survey on earning structure – conducting of this survey provides the data on links between the level of earning and individual characteristics of employees (age, sex, years of working experience, educational attainment) as well as characteristics of their employers (economic activity, size and location of enterprise). The survey was conducted in 2015, on the sample of 1068 reporting units, and funded by IPA project;
9. Pilot survey on turnover of pesticide was conducted in November 2015 in cooperation with Phytosanitary Administration;
10. Annual report on catch of white fish and shellfish in sea aquaculture harmonized with the Regulation (EC) No 762/2008 of 9 July 2008, on the submission by Member States of statistics on aquaculture and repealing Council Regulation;
11. Report on production of fish in fishponds – aquaculture - harmonized with the Regulation (EC) No 762/2008 of 9 July 2008 that refer to submission of statistical data on aquaculture and sea aquaculture;
12. Register of agriculture holdings has been established and updated by using internal and external sources. It is only used for statistical purposes.

Of special importance – due to the connection with other negotiation chapters, but also due to significant financial resources for their realization, we would like to point out the following surveys:

- 1. Implementation of ESA 2010 methodology in the calculation of annual and quarterly gross domestic product** (implies the fulfilment of obligations defined by the negotiation position for Chapter 18 - Statistics, and are also important for Chapter 17 – Economic and monetary policy, Chapter 33 – Financial and budgetary provisions, and Chapter 16 - Taxation);
- 2. Calculation of macroeconomic aggregate of gross national income in accordance with ESA 2010 methodology** (implies the fulfilment of obligations defined by the negotiation position for Chapter 18 - Statistics, and of importance is also for Chapter 17 - Economic and monetary policy, Chapter 33 - Financial and budgetary provisions and Chapter 16 - Taxation);
- 3. Conducting the survey on structure of income and intermediary consumption by activities (SPIR), as the basis for the calculation of supply and use table** - implies practically the census of economy, and the data are used for the improvement of calculation of gross domestic products and creation of supply and use table, as one of conditions for closing Chapter 18 - Statistics, having in mind that the data from the mentioned survey, i.e. supply and use table represent the basis for the negotiation of Chapter 33 - Financial and budgetary provisions, in part of defining tax basis of Montenegro for the participation in the budget of European Union;
- 4. Harmonized index of consumer prices** (because of demands defined by negotiation Chapter 17 - Economic and monetary policy as well as because of Maastricht criteria in context that Montenegro is euro zone economy);
- 5. Survey on structure of agricultural holdings** (because of demands defined by negotiation Chapter 11 - Agriculture and rural development for needs to access structure funds and subventions for the development of agriculture. These data play a key role in design, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation of Common Agricultural Policy - CAP);
- 6. Agricultural accounts** (imply development and introduction of new surveys aimed at presentation of agriculture sector through an integral system of accounts, and due to negotiation Chapter 11 - Agriculture and rural development to access structure funds and subventions for development of agriculture).

2.1.1 Statistical surveys not carried out under competence of Statistical Office

Out of a total of 192 planned statistical surveys under competence of Statistical Office, three statistical surveys have not been carried out, which is 1% of the total number of surveys planned by Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015.

The reason for not carrying out the report on incubator station activities is the absence of incubation stations in the reporting year, while the reason for not carrying out the survey on vineyard structure – grapevine for other purposes, a lack of financial resources as well as that statistical register of agricultural holdings is not updated with the administrative source data. Due to a lack of human resources, the ESSPROS survey is not completely carried out, but there have been started with the aim to completely carry out this survey. The survey results are expected in the following period, during 2016 and 2017 with support of IPA 2013 national assistance project.

2.2 Implementation of Annual plan of official statistics for 2015 under competence of other official statistical producers

Other official statistical producers carried out all 45 statistical surveys planned by the Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015. Results of statistical surveys are available to users on official website of other official statistical producers.

The list of carried out statistical surveys is set out in the annex to the Report, in accordance with the Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015.

Other official statistical producers participate in the preparation and implementation of:

- Programme of official statistics for period 2014-2018;
- Annual plan of official statistics;
- Calendar of publishing statistical data, and
- Report on implementation of Programme and Annual plan of official statistics.

During 2015 there were held 4 sessions of Statistical System Council aimed at giving expert opinions and proposals pursuant to Article 13 of the Law.

3. IMPROVEMENTS ACHIEVED STATISTICAL SURVEYS OF STATISTICAL OFFICE IN 2015

Improvements were done in the following statistical areas:

- A. Macro-economic statistics;
- B. Statistics of agriculture;
- C. Statistics of environment and forestry;
- D. Business statistics;
- E. Social statistics, and
- F. Sector for national coordination.

A. Macro-economic statistics

a) National Accounts

Improvements done in the national accounts – NA in 2015 are the following:

- Methodology ESA 2010 implemented in the calculation of annual gross domestic product (GDP) for period 2010-2013. Methodological changes in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology that had influence on the GDP level refer to: ‘capitalization of costs of ‘research and development’ and ‘capitalization of costs of military weapon’. Additionally, additional statistical improvements were done referring at: improving calculation of FISIM, government expenditure, and imputed rent, carried out aimed at harmonization of EU standards;
- Final results of annual GDP for 2014 published by production and consumption method in current and constant prices, according to NACE Rev.2 activity classification, in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology;
- Time series annual GDP for period 2010-2014 has been published, in accordance with the ESA 2010 programme for data transmission submitted to EUROSTAT via Edamis web portal through SDMX format;
- Methodology ESA 2010 implemented in the calculation of quarterly gross domestic product (GDP) for period 1st quarter of 2010 – 3rd quarter of 2015;
- Macro-economic aggregate published: gross national income for period 2010-2014 in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology;
- Experimental calculation of non-financial accounts for government sector for 2011 done on the basis of available data of Ministry of Finance according to the ESA 95 methodology;
- Experimental calculation of GDP by income approach for period 2011-2013 done according to the ESA 95 methodology;
- Time series of quarterly GDP published for period 1st quarter of 2010 – 3rd quarter of 2015, in accordance with the ESA 2010 programme for data transmission and submitted to EUROSTAT-u via Edamis web portal through SDMX format;
- Metadata on the website of Statistical Office updated;
- Metadata for the needs of General Data Dissemination System – GDDS updated in the framework of International Monetary Fund - IMF.

b) Foreign trade

The following improvements were done in the statistics of foreign trade, in 2015:

- Mirror analysis done that refer to the data comparison of foreign trade of goods with the EU member countries and other countries with the important foreign trade of goods as well as updating strategic guideline and national report on foreign trade statistics of Montenegro.

Mirror analysis was prepared for period 2009-2013 at the aggregate level and for period 2012-2013 at the detailed level of classification Combined Nomenclature (8-digit level);

- Metadata for needs of General Data Dissemination System – GDDS updated in the framework of International Monetary Fund - IMF.

c) Structural survey on enterprise operation

The following improvements were done in structural business statistics in 2015:

- Compiled and processed data on operation of enterprises for 2014, methodologically harmonized with the Regulation (EC) No 295/2008, that defines a framework for collection, processing, and publishing the data on enterprise operations;
- Analysis 'Enterprise operations in Montenegro in 2004' published on the official website of Statistical Office. The analysis comprises main indicators of Montenegrin business by different activities, and classes of enterprises;
- Report on quality for structural business statistics – SBS prepared for reference year 2013.

d) Foreign affiliates statistics - FATS

The following improvements were done for foreign affiliates statistics in 2015:

- Data for statistics of foreign and domestic affiliates for 2014 compiled and processed;
- Release for domestic affiliates statistics for 2014 published;
- Report on quality for foreign affiliates statistics prepared for reference year 2013.

e) Price statistics

The following improvements were done for price statistics in 2015:

- Harmonized index of consumer prices – HICP, pilot survey was carried out in administrative prices, and indices for period 2010-2015 calculated;
- Harmonized index of consumer prices – HICP, pilot survey carried out in constant tax rates, and indices for period 2010-2011 calculated, in accordance with the Regulation (EC) No 119/2013;
- Detailed working methodology (Inventory) produced for Harmonized index of consumer prices, and submitted to EUROSTAT, as a fulfilment of obligation defined by joint negotiation position for Chapter 18 - Statistics;
- Within framework of Index of industrial product prices there are calculated indices by main industrial groups – MIGs, and data transmitted to EUROSTAT in September, for period from January 2010 together with the last available data;
- Metadata for needs of General Data Dissemination System – GDDS updated under the framework of International Monetary Fund - IMF.

B. Statistics of agriculture

Within the framework of statistics of agriculture there has been established *Statistical Register of Agricultural Holdings* and its updating is constantly done by using internal and external sources. Statistical register of agricultural holdings is only used for statistical purposes.

a) Economic Accounts for Agriculture - EAA and agricultural prices

Following results are achieved related to economic accounts in agriculture and agricultural prices:

- Method designed for the calculation of agricultural absolute prices and index of agricultural product prices and resources and services invested in agriculture in accordance with:

- Handbook for EU Agricultural Price Statistics, March 2008, and
- Draft agreement on statistics for agricultural land prices and rents;

In accordance with the achieved results, the following reports produced and sent to Eurostat:

- Agricultural Absolute Prices Inventory;
- Agricultural Prices Indices Inventory;
- Agricultural Land Prices and Rents.

- Method designed for the calculation of agricultural production account (value of agriculture-output) in accordance with:

- Regulation (EC) No 138/2004, Regulation (EC) No 138/2004 of the European parliament and of the Council of 5 December 2003 on the economic accounts for agriculture in the Community.

In accordance with the achieved results, the following report was prepared and sent to Eurostat:

- Inventory of the Economic Accounts for Agriculture - EAA methodology in Montenegro in cooperation with Biotechnical Faculty.

b) Statistics of livestock

Following results are achieved in livestock statistics:

- Within the framework of slaughtering statistics on bovine animals, pigs, sheep, and goats, and poultry, calculation were done for gross indigenous production of meat and meat production forecasts (*GIP forecast model*) in accordance with the EU Regulation No 1165/2008 of the European Parliament and Council concerning livestock and meat statistics;

- Electronic data collection done within the framework of annual survey on livestock of agricultural holdings, as a pilot project for municipalities Podgorica and Danilovgrad. The application has been done in BLAISE program.

c) Crop statistics

Following results are achieved in crop statistics:

- Aimed at the harmonization of crop statistics with the Regulation (EC) No 543/2009 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 June 2009 concerning crop statistics, there has been finished the recalculation of data series for period 2007-2013, and data are submitted to Eurostat via e-DAMIS web portal.

d) Fishery statistics

Following results are accomplished in fishery statistics:

- In area of fishery statistics, two new surveys were carried out not planned by Annual Plan of Official Statistics for 2015, and they arise as the result of Fishery Working Group's activities in accordance with agriculture and rural development as the following:
 - Annual report on white-flesh fish shellfish production in maritime aquaculture
 - Report on fish production in fishponds– aquaculture.

C. Environmental statistics

The results were achieved in waste statistics as a constituent part of environmental statistics:

- In cooperation with the Agency for environmental protection, there were collected and published the data in area of waste statistics, in accordance with the Commission Regulation (EU) No 849/2010 of 27 September 2010 amending Regulation (EC) No 2150/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council on waste statistics.

Data were transmitted via e-DAMIS web portal to Eurostat for 2013 and 2014.

D. Business statistics

a) Business statistics and short-term indicators

The following improvements in 2015 were done:

- In cooperation with the Energy Community Secretariat and Energy Institute 'Hrvoje Pozar' from Croatia, there was carried out a survey on energy consumption in industry, public and commercial sector in Montenegro for 2014, in accordance with Regulation (EC) No 1099/2008 and Regulation (EC) No 147/2013;
- Monthly questionnaires on oil products (JODI and MOSOIL) for 2013 were transmitted via e-DAMIS web portal for the first time to Eurostat;
- Methodological guideline *Investments in Fixed Assets* revised in accordance with the methodology ESA 2010;
- Metadata prepared for surveys on turnover in other services and prices of dwellings in new buildings;
- Data collection improved via e-questionnaire for statistical survey '*Retail trade*'.
- Work on preparation of e-questionnaire started for electronic data collection on tourist arrivals and overnight stays;
- Applications for data entering improved for almost all surveys of business statistics;
- Tourism statistics improved by entering into force a new Law on Tourist Organization (Official Gazette of Republic of Montenegro No 11/04 of 20 February 2004, 46/07 of 31 July 2007, Official Gazette of Montenegro No 73/10 of 10 December 2010, 40/11 of 8 August 2011, 45/14 of 24 October 2014), coverage and quality of data improved on tourist turnover in individual accommodation;
- Quarterly data on road freight transport were sent via e-DAMIS web portal to Eurostat for the first time, in accordance with the Regulation (EC) No 1172/98, and the Regulation No 70/2012.

In accordance with the results achieved, the following reports were prepared:

- on quality for index of physical volume of industrial production;

- on quality for index of turnover in industry;
- on quality for index retail trade;
- on quality for index turnover in other services;
- on quality for construction activity;
- on quality for price of dwellings in new building;
- on quality for construction permits.

E. Social Statistics

a) Statistics of income and living conditions– SILC

Progress achieved in 2015 is the following:

- Methodologically improved questionnaires and added secondary variables in questionnaires for 2015, and all in accordance with the Regulation (EU) No 67/2014 and methodology defined by Eurostat for this area of statistics (EU-SILC 065 - Description of target variables: Cross-sectional and longitudinal);
- Guideline for Interviewers improved;
- Programme for entering of data on income and living conditions statistics improved;
- Application for logical and accounting control of entered data on income and living conditions statistics;
- Data on income and living conditions for 2013 submitted to Eurostat-u via e-DAMIS web portal, e-DAMIS web application.

In accordance with the achieved results, the following report prepared and sent to Eurostat:

- Report on activities carried out for EU SILC 2014 - Progress report.

b) Education statistics:

- Data collection improved; a change from reporting method to administrative records use for statistical purposes (preschool, primary and secondary education).

c) Crime statistics:

- Cooperation agreement signed on the exchange of administrative data with the *Secretariat of Judicial Council and Supreme State Prosecutor of Montenegro*, reducing the overburden of reporting units.

d) Culture statistics:

- Agreement on cooperation and exchange of administrative data with the Agency for Electronic Media signed and cooperation agreed on establishing electronic media statistics.

e) Statistics of international migration:

- Cooperation on agreement signed for exchange of administrative data with the Ministry of Interiors aimed at the establishment of asylum statistics, illegal migration and gaining and losing citizenship.

F. Sector for National Coordination

a. Coordination of official statistical system

Coordination role of Statistical Office in the statistical system of Montenegro is defined by Article 8 of Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System, which defines that Statistical Office is the main coordinator of official statistical system.

During 2015, the coordination was strengthened in effective manner through the number of instruments:

1. Sector for National Coordination of Statistical Sources has been established that coordinates official statistical system at the level of Montenegro. The tasks within the framework of sector relate to the following:
 - a. Coordination and cooperation with official statistical producers;
 - b. establishment of cooperation with administrative data sources and other relevant institutions competent for managing administrative records;
 - c. Coordination of Council of Statistical System;
 - d. establishment of cooperation with scientific and research institutions, universities;
 - e. Drafting laws and secondary legislation of statistical system (Law on Statistics, Development Strategy, Five-Year Programme, Memorandum on Cooperation, Annual Plan, Report on Implementation of Annual Plan, etc.);
 - f. Consultations of Statistical Office with users so that the users' community can be extended;
 - g. And other tasks related to the coordination.
2. Two procedures adopted that regulate the coordination inside statistical system:
 - h. Procedure on accession of statistical producer in the official statistical system of Montenegro (No 01-293 of 9 February 2015);
 - i. Procedure on administrative data source use for needs of official statistics (No 01-1886 of 2 June 2015);
3. Statistical Office devoted in 2015 a special attention to the cooperation with administrative data sources and other relevant institutions competent for keeping administrative records. This process is also supported through the European integration process (through Chapter 18 - Statistics) where the role of Statistical Office, as the coordinator of statistical system of Montenegro is put in the first place. Aimed at the improvements of official statistical system and defining plans for the harmonization of Chapter 18 – Statistics with EU standards, Statistical Office has started an initiative for formalization of interinstitutional relation both with official producers and administrative sources.

Statistical Office has signed 6 agreements with the holders of administrative sources aimed at the improvements of official statistical system:

- **Ministry of Interiors** in the area of statistics on crime, migration, and international protection as well as transport accidents, injured persons and road transport of goods;
- **Supreme state prosecutor** in the area of statistics on crime that represents a part of judicial statistics;
- **Secretariat of Judicial Council** in the area of judicial statistics;
- **Ministry of Justice** in area of education statistics;
- **Agency for Electronic Media** in the area of electronic media statistics;

- **Agency for electronic communication and postal activity** aimed at the data and information exchange between parties that signed the agreement in accordance with laws that regulate their activity.

Signing the agreement will improve the interinstitutional cooperation that is necessary for the establishment of functional system for the production of official statistics, both for national and European needs. In this manner, there will be avoided double statistical data at the level of Montenegro, reduced costs of data collection and overburden of reporting units.

4. Montenegro official statistical system has been extended with one more producer of official statistics, Ministry of Science, in the area of R&D statistics in accordance with the amendments to the Programme of Official Statistics 2014-2018.

b. Business register

Improvements done in 2015 are the following:

- *Release on Number and Structure of Business Entities in Foreign Ownership in 2004*¹; on official website of Statistical Office has been published
- Two surveys were carried out: Survey on Business of Middle and Large Enterprises, and Survey on enterprises that have units in their composition;
- In accordance with the Regulation (EC) 177/08^[1] the first example of profiling complex enterprises (Desk profiling) was done.

c. Classifications

Improvements done in 2015 are the following:

- Full implementation of Statistical Classification of Activity by Product - CPA 08 in statistical domains concerned;
- Implementation of GEONOM classification in foreign trade statistics.

3.1 Data dissemination and public relations

In 2015 there was printed and published 6 publications, published 282 releases (monthly, quarterly, and annual). Published releases are improved in terms of design, text, graph, contents. Data accessibility increased on official website, due to the translation of all contents in English language.

3.1.1 Public relations

In 2015, Statistical Office held 5 press conferences:

- Publication of preliminary results of gross domestic product for 2014 (April 2015);
- Publication of gross domestic product (GDP) by consumption method for 1st quarter 2015 (July 2015);
- Publication of gross domestic product (GDP) in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology: final results of annual GDP for 2014, revised data series for period 2010 – 2013 and preliminary results of quarterly BDP for 2nd quarter of 2015 (September 2015);
- Publication of “Energy Survey Results in Service Sector in Montenegro 2014“ (December 2015);
- Publication of quarterly gross domestic product (QGDP) in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology (preliminary results of quarterly GDP for the 2nd quarter 2015, and revised data series for period 2010 – 2014) and Gross National Income in accordance with the ESA 2010 methodology for period 2010-2014 (December 2015).

Official mail of Statistical Office received 630 user requests in 2015. Of total number of requests, there are 583 that refer to requests for data and information from foreign institutions, while 47 requests were received from media. The most requested data refer to the area of foreign trade statistics (228 requests), and short-term indicators (103 requests).

Requests by frequency are sent to the following domains in Statistical Office, and presented in Table 4.

3.2 Other development activities (IT activities)

3.2.1 Technical conditions

For the purpose of simplified overview of data on official website of Statistical Office, there was drafted a project task "*Development of Dissemination Database*".

a) Hardware improvements:

- New web server provided for portal, enabling the access to reporting units to applications for electronic data entering;
- New hardware equipment for e-mail (e-mail server) provided.

b) Improvement of system security:

- Improved protection against unauthorised internet access to servers of Statistical Office, by purchase and installation of hardware (CISCO ASA firewall).

c) Software licencing:

- All software of Statistical Office licensed and the newest Windows user license installed:
 - MS Windows 8.1 Enterprise, for 126 users;
 - Microsoft Office Professional Plus 2013, for 126 users.
- There were provided the following server licenses:
 - Windows Server Standard 2012, six licenses R2;
 - SQL¹ Server Standard 2014, six licenses;
 - CAL (Client access licenses) za SQL Server;
 - Two licenses for Exchange Server Standard;
 - CAL for 150 users for Exchange Server.
- For development and improvement of application, there were purchased ten licenses for software for the development of web application (Visual Basic Studio).

d) Antivirus protection

- Corporate antivirus program Kaspersky for 130 users installed.

3.2.2 Programming

Modernisation of data collection, processing, and dissemination in 2015 introduced the following methods:

- Data collection via internet – CAWI method, used in statistical survey “*Monthly survey of retail trade*”. For the purpose of implementing CAWI method, the web portal was developed;
- Data collection by using lap top - CAPI method, was implemented in the survey “Survey on Number of Livestock”. Blaise application was developed for this survey;
- New program tools Visual Basic.net, Blaise, and SQL Server 2014 started to be used for electronic storage and keeping the data for the purpose of providing electronic records durability.

a) New applications

In 2015 new applications were developed for the following statistical surveys:

- Survey on earning structure;
- Survey Way to School and to Employment in 2015;
- Survey on consumption of energy in industry, public, and commercial sector in Montenegro, in 2014;
- Survey Structure of income and expenditures of business entities, entrepreneurs, and budget users.

Additionally, an application for monitoring the implementation of IPA 2014 MB programme - GRANT project developed.

b) Program improvements:

- Application updated for Survey on income and expenditure in holdings and enterprises.

4. INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND INTEGRATION IN INTERNATIONAL STATISTICAL SYSTEM

4.1. European integration

Montenegro opened Chapter 18 - Statistics in December 2014.

Within the framework of European integration process, Chapter 18 – Statistics has been assessed in the Montenegro progress report for 2015 by European Commission for the first time in accordance with the new methodology for assessment, according to which Chapter 18 – Statistics one of 5 ‘pilot chapters’ where the new methodology was used.

Chapter 18 - Statistics has been assessed based on two aspects, one of which is referring to the assessment of readiness of one country to become an EU member country, and the second aspect refer to achieved progress. For 2015 Chapter 18 - Statistics was assessed by ‘some progress’, and ‘some level of preparation’. Two recommendations of European Commission were given in the progress report:

1. Considerably strengthen the human and financial resources, and
2. Further align the statistics with ESA 2010, including government finance statistics.

Statistical Office organizes at the quarterly level meetings of working group for Chapter 18 - Statistics, and the purpose of these meetings that all members are acquainted with the activities in the process of harmonization with the Chapter, with special focus on benchmarks defined by common negotiation position in September 2014.

Statistical Office is an active participant in the harmonization process of other chapters where Statistical Office has its representative. Statistical Office is a member of total 14 working groups of other negotiation chapter.

1. Chapter 2 – Freedom of movement for workers;
2. Chapter 11 - Agriculture and rural development;
3. Chapter 12 – Food safety, veterinary and phytosanitary policy;
4. Chapter 13 – Fisheries;
5. Chapter 16 - Taxation;
6. Chapter 17 - Economic and monetary policy;
7. Chapter 19 - Social policy and employment;
8. Chapter 20 – Enterprise and industrial policy;
9. Chapter 22 - Regional policy and coordination of structural instruments;
10. Chapter 25 – Science and research;
11. Subgroup for Chapter 27 - Environment and climate change;
12. Chapter 29 – Customs union;
13. Chapter 30 – External relations;
14. Chapter 33 – Financial and budgetary provisions

Within the framework of Montenegro’s Accession Programme to the European Union for period 2016-2018, Statistical Office defined legal, strategic, and administrative framework from the aspect of current state and future plans in the mentioned period. Montenegro’s Accession Programme to the European Union also considered the assessment of relevance of new CELEX numbers dedicated to Montenegro under Chapter 18 – Statistics.

A video conference between Montenegro and European Commission regarding the benchmarks for Chapter 18-Statistics was held in June 2015.

Benchmarks for temporary closing Chapter 18-Statistics are:

1. Submit the key data of National Accounts - NA in accordance with ESA 2010 methodology and other relevant requests together with the detailed description of used methodology, and
2. Submit the road map to Commission for the transmission of the rest of tables from data transmission program via the ESA 2010 data transmission program.

European Commission welcomed the progress achieved in previous period, and a special attention was put on benchmarks for temporary closing Chapter 18-Statistics. The aim of conference was to discuss with the European Commission about the next activities and dynamics of their implementation aimed at fulfilment of benchmarks. European Commission welcomed the efforts Statistical Office invested to align the NA data with the ESA 2010 methodology, stressing that further progress demand strengthened human resources of Statistical Office.

Video conference was participated in addition to the representatives of Statistical Office and European Commission, also representatives of Ministry of Foreign Affairs and European Integration, Central Bank of Montenegro, and Ministry of Finance.

4.2 International projects

With approval and support of Eurostat, and within the framework of IPA II multi-beneficiary programme (2014-2018), Statistical Office has become a direct coordinator of 'GRANT contract', whose implementation started in 2015. A special significance of this type of contract is reflected in part that IPA MB project funds are directly given to a national statistical institution to manage it. It is emphasized that this type of contract enables additional financial resources for Statistical Office having a significant influence on faster development of official statistical system. Aimed at efficient use of donor resources through GRANT contracts, Statistical Office has established during 2015 a system for preparation and implementation of GRANT contract. Coordination and monitoring of system is done by Department for Implementation of International Statistical Projects.

In 2015 staff members of Statistical Office and other relevant institutions of Montenegro participated in 145 international conferences, meetings, workshops, trainings, and other study visits out of Montenegro aimed at improvements of official statistical system of Montenegro.

IPA 2012 multi-beneficiary:

- 108 horizontal activities;

IPA 2014 multi-beneficiary:

- 9 horizontal activities;

IPA 2010 NATIONAL:

- 5 study visits;

International meetings:

- 23 meetings.

a) IPA 2010 National project

Project IPA 2010 has been finished, with the implementation period May 2013 - May 2015. Project implementation was prolonged from 24 to 26 months aimed at carrying out all planned activities. The results produced by the project are conceptualized as following four (4) components:

- Component 1: Agriculture statistics - introducing new surveys, improving methods for data collection and development of the SFR;
- Component 2: National accounts - further harmonization of National accounts and price statistics;
- Component 3: Business statistics; harmonizing business statistics with EU standards;
- Component 4: IT & sampling - improving IT support and metadata in accordance with EU and international standards including sampling.

The conclusion is that objectives related to four components, and including all requests of users were achieved and adequately supported from the point of sustainable factors, such as participation and ownership of project users, support policy, adequate technology as well as institutional and management capacities of Statistical Office.

b) IPA 2012 multi-beneficiary project

IPA 2012 multi-beneficiary project –project duration is December 2013 - November 2015. The project covers the following areas:

- Methodology of national accounts;
- Agro-monetary Statistics;
- Annual crop statistics;
- Livestock statistics;
- Survey on earning structure;
- Short-term statistics;
- International trade of goods;
- International trade of services;
- Survey on income and living conditions - SILC;
- Price statistics – purchasing power parity;
- Price statistics – HICP.

In 2015, under project, there were carried out 108 activities participated by 144 staff members. Three staff members of Statistical Office and one staff members of Central Bank were on the traineeship in Eurostat within the framework of the project during 2015.

c) IPA 2014 multi-beneficiary project - GRANT

IPA 2014 multi-beneficiary project – GRANT, planned project duration is October 2015 - August 2017. With approval and support of Eurostat, Statistical Office is within the framework of IPA II multi-beneficiary programme (2014-2018) has become a direct coordinator of GRANT contract with the implementation in 2015. Use of these contracts has an advantage in part that the dedicated funds of IPA MB project are allocated directly to national statistical institute to manage it. Under this programme, Statistical Office manages the following processes: staff education through the presence of large number of trainings, implementation of pilot projects, with support of expert assistance and organization of study visits in

other national statistical institutes. Within the framework of programme, the following pilot projects are included:

- National Accounts Methodology;
- ESA 2010 Transmission Programme; QNA;
- PPP;
- Business statistics - profiling methodology, statistical unit enterprise, EGR, enterprise groups in SBR ;
- ICT usage in households, by individuals, in enterprises;
- Transport statistics - Passenger and freight statistics;
- Short-term statistics;
- Tourism statistics;
- Harmonized index of consumer prices;
- Annual crop statistics;
- Livestock statistics;
- Farm Structure Survey.

Within the framework of this programme in 2015, there were carried 9 activities participated by 8 staff members.

d) Projects funded by United Nations – UN

1. International monetary fund (IMF)

Statistical Office participated in 2015 in course “*System of national accounts*“ organized by IMF from 20 July to 14 August 2015 in Washington, United States of America - USA.

2. United Nations for Development - UNDP

- In July 2014, agreement signed between UNDP and Statistical Office, when Statistical Office took over the role to prepare, organize, and produce material flows and domestic material consumption - DMC indicators in Montenegro. The role of Statistical Office in this project reflected in the analysis of existing situation, when considering material flows and DMC indicators in Montenegro as well as the very draft of the mentioned indicators. The result of project is publication presented to the public in February 2015. The publication met the key aim, i.e. drafting indicators and from this point of view it significantly enriched the official statistics of Statistical Office.
- In September 2014 there was signed an agreement between UNDP and Statistical Office aimed at the implementation of project “*Biannual updating report on climate changes*” with duration of 8 months. Statistical Office was engaged as one of several implementation partners. The aim of project is providing support to Montenegro on integration recommendations related to climate changes in national and sector development policies, through process of strengthening of institutional and technical capacities partly started with the drafting national report on climate changes. The project was ended on April 2015, after which the key results were presented to the public.

3. The United Nations Children’s Fund - UNICEF

- In 2015 Statistical Office in cooperation with UNICEF coordinated the data collection at the annual level for the purpose of updating the *TransMonEE* database. *TransMonEE* captures a vast range of data relevant to social and economic issues relevant to the situation and wellbeing of children, young people and women in Eastern Europe and Central Asia. The coordinator of data collection for updating the *TransMonEE* database is Statistical

Office, and the data collection is done at the interinstitutional level in cooperation with the following institutions: Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare, Institute for Public Health, Police Administration, Institution for Enforcement of Criminal Sanctions, Pension and Disability Insurance Fund, Hospital for pulmonary diseases 'Dr Jovan Bulajic' Brezovik, Employment Office of Montenegro, and Women Safety House.

- Within the cooperation with UNICEF, Statistical Office prepared a country analytical report - CAR with the title "*Disaggregation of data on children by ethnicity*".

4. International Labour Organization – ILO

Upon request of Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare, Statistical Office carried out a survey 'Way to School and Employment' within the project of International Labour Organization - ILO. Regarding it, there was signed an agreement with ILO, period: May-December 2015. Statistical Office carried out the survey and submitted the results to ILO. The target group of surveys was youth, aged 15-29 years as well as time they spent and activities they done from the moment of going to the labour market and until they found 'stable' job. Project activities are done in accordance with signed agreement.

e) Project financed by Energy Community Secretariat

Upon the initiative of Energy Community Secretariat, and within the framework of project for strengthening energy statistics, Statistical Office carried out the annual survey on consumption of energy in industry, public, and commercial sector in 2004. On the basis of proposals of Statistical Office and compulsory statement No 01-3859 of 1 December 2014, Energy Community Secretariat approved the funding of project in the amount of budget envisaged, including technical assistance of consultant that performed the surveillance under project implementation. Technical assistance and monitoring the use of funds for the purpose of implementation project was done by Energy Institute 'Hrvoje Pozar' Zagreb, Croatia on the basis of contract No UG-15-00034.

5. EXTERNAL REVISIONS AND CONTROLS

In 2015 two external revisions and controls were done in Statistical Office. One referred to the control of public procurement from the Administration for Inspection, Department for Inspection of Public Procurement, while the subject of the second revision and control of invoice payment process by the side of Ministry of Finance - Department for Internal Revision:

- Control of invoice payment process by Department for Internal Revision of Ministry of Finance, was done in period 20 November 2015 to 3 December 2015. In report draft and report on revisions it was mentioned that the invoice payment process that was subject of revision was done adequately and effectively;
- Inspection control of public procurement referred to conclusions and realization of public procurement contract. The inspection noted that the contracts were concluded in accordance with decisions on selection of the most favourable tender, in accordance with the request for submitting tender by shopping, by call for public procurement and tender dossier. It was noted that invoices for goods and services were done in accordance with the accepted prices from the most favourable tenders among tender received.

6. FINANCES AND HUMAN RESOURCES

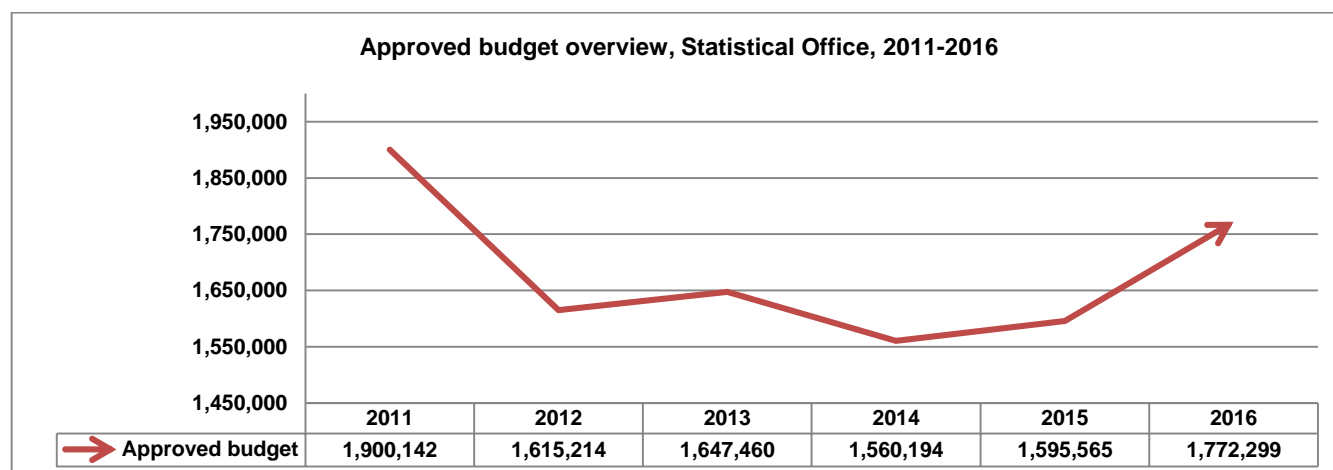
6.1 Financial resources

Approved budget of Statistical Office for 2015 is 1.59 million of euro, divided into two programmes: Programme of Statistical Surveys, analyses and informing, and Programme of Administration.

Implemented regular budget resources are 1.56 million of euro, i.e. 98% out of the total approved budget.

Public Procurement Plan 2015 (No 01-250 of 28 January 2015) envisages the implementation of public procurement in value of 151 658.05 euro. During 2015 there were realized total 16 procurements by shopping method, and 5 public procurement processes. Public procurement done in 2015 was 138 534.22 euro in total (91% of the total planned).

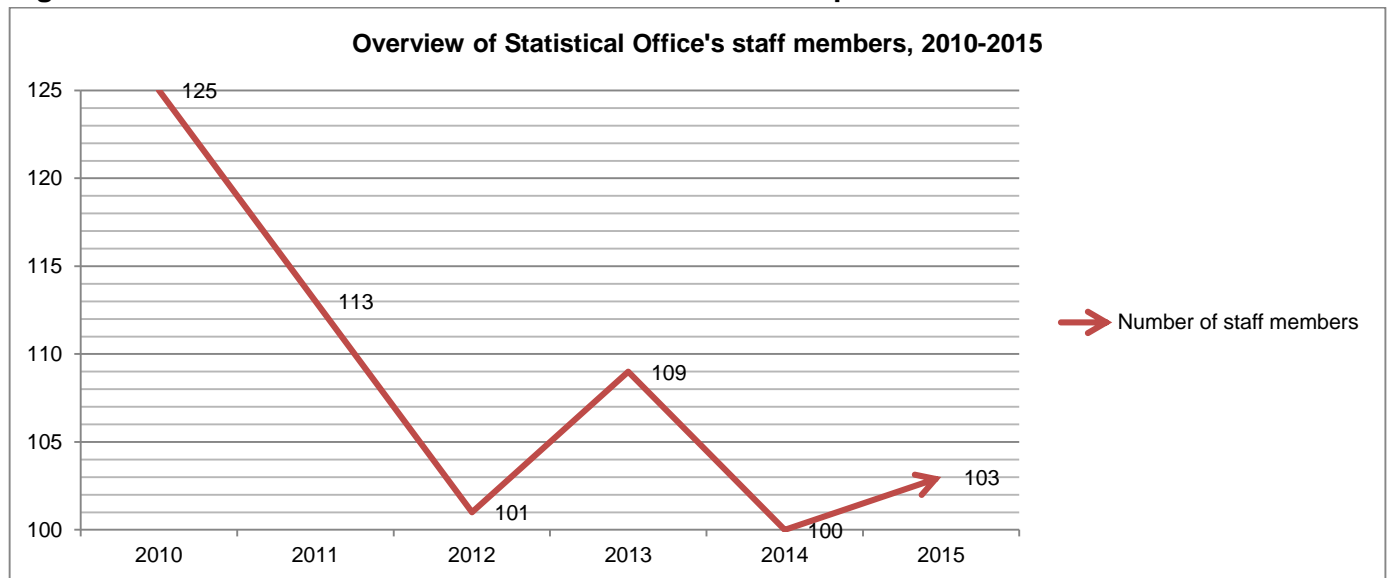
Figure 1: Approved Statistical Office's budget overview for period 2011-2016



6.2 Human and space resources

The Rulebook on Internal Organization Job Descriptions of Statistical Office envisages 200 staff members. At the end of 2015 in Statistical Office there were employed 103 staff members.

Ministry of Finance has given the consent to Statistical Office for Human Resources Plan for 2015, and approved the employment of 7 staff members. Accordingly, in 2015, based on open competition there were employed 2 staff members on temporary basis – high management staff, and on the basis of open competition 5 staff members on permanent basis (4 staff members – expert staff and 1 staff member – operational staff). Additionally, in 2015, based on the conducted open competition, there was employed 1 staff member on temporary basis – trainee.

At the end of 2015, a consensual termination of employment was asked by 3 staff members, to which the decision on termination of employment was given.
