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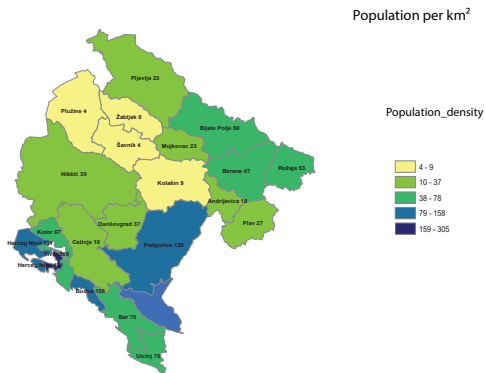

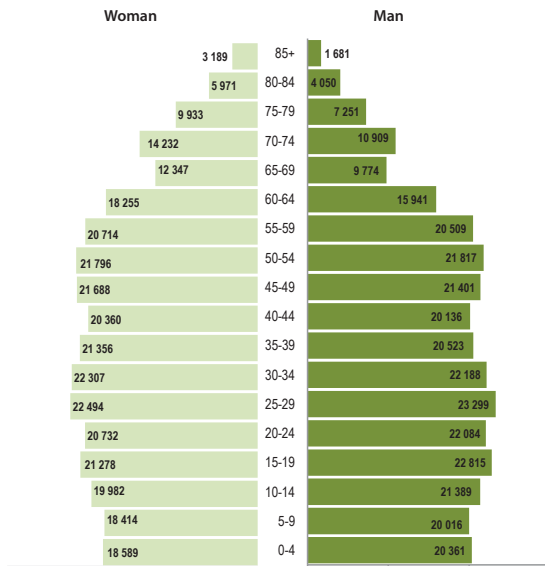

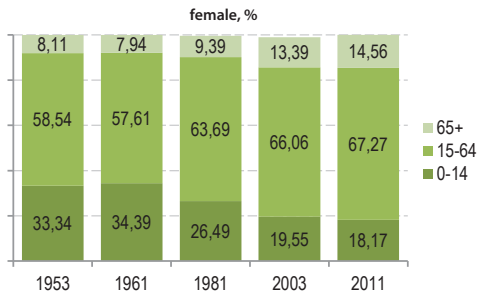

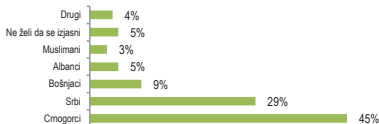

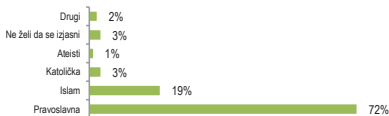

Ethnic structure, Census 2011



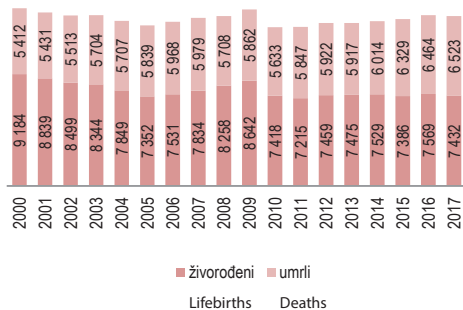
Religion structure, Census 2011

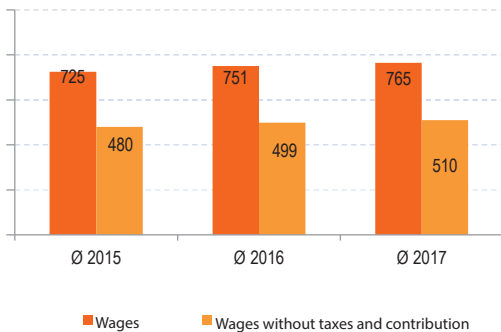

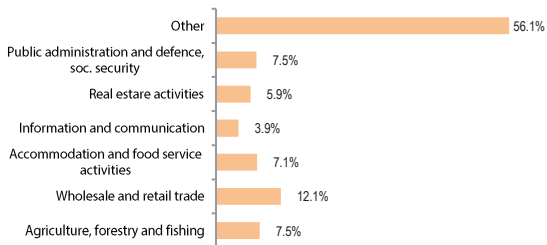

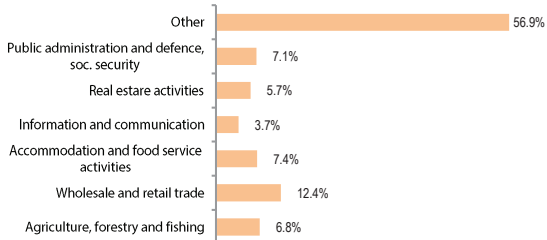

Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2016

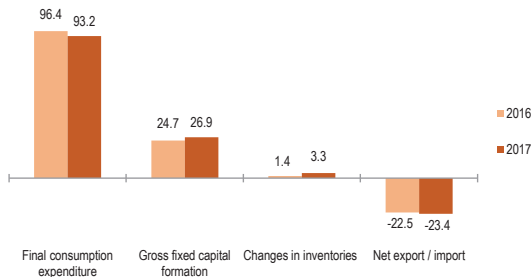


Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2017



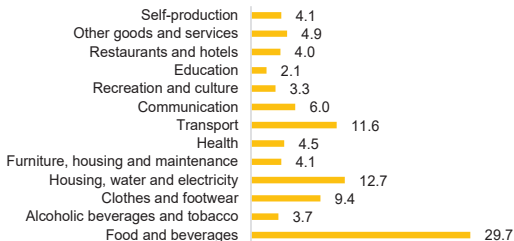

2016 and 2017

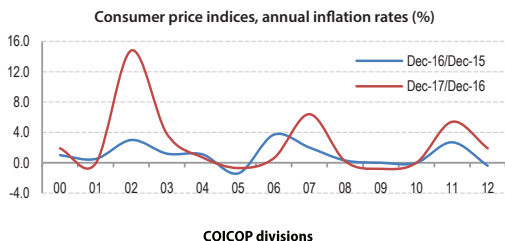
