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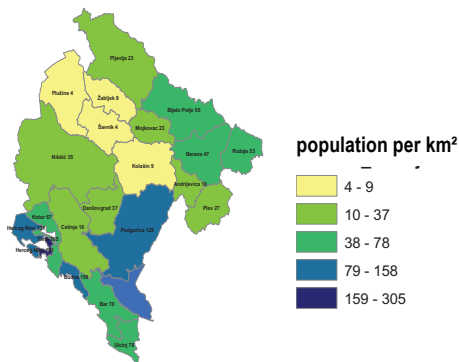

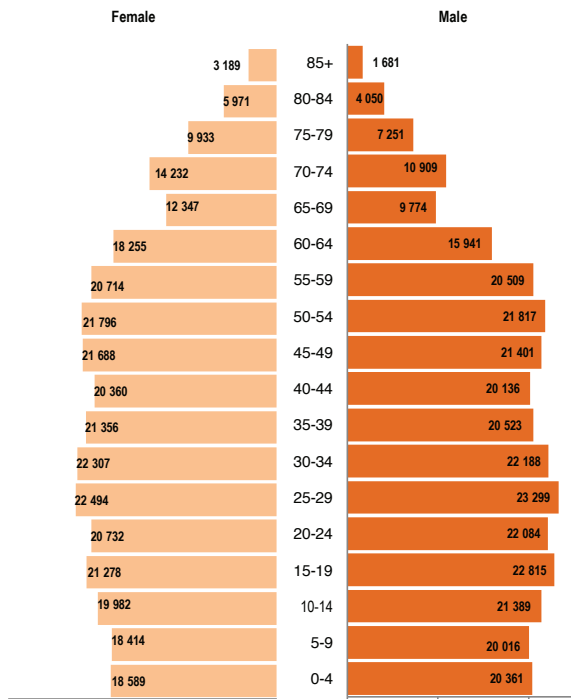

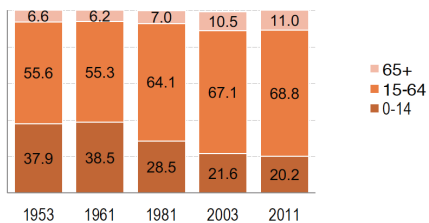

Population by age group and sex, Census 2011

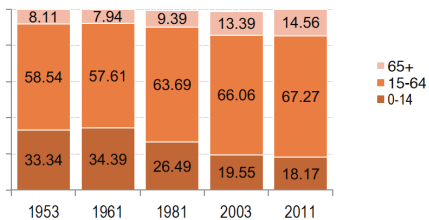


## Population by age group, Censuses

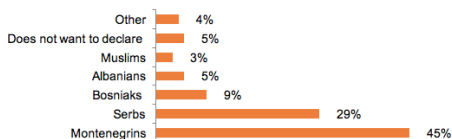

## Population aged 15 and over by marital status, Census 2011

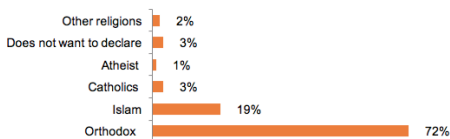

### Religion structure, Census 2011

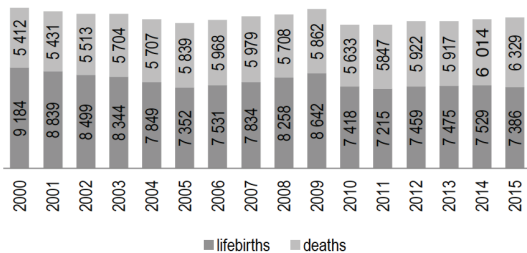

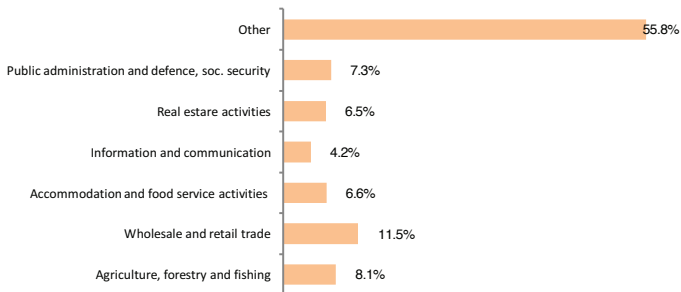

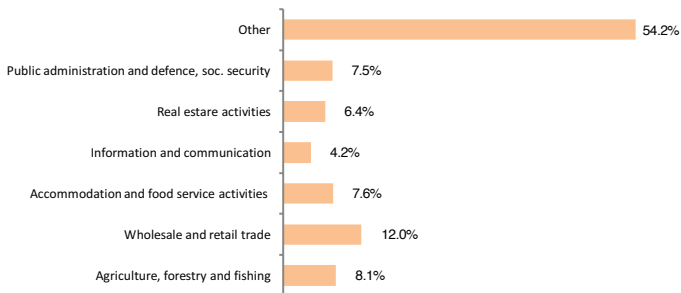

### Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2014

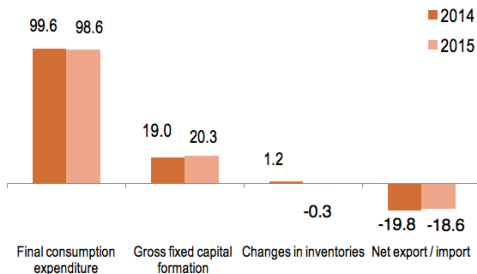


### Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2015

### Structure of GDP by type of expenditure at current prices, 2014 and 2015



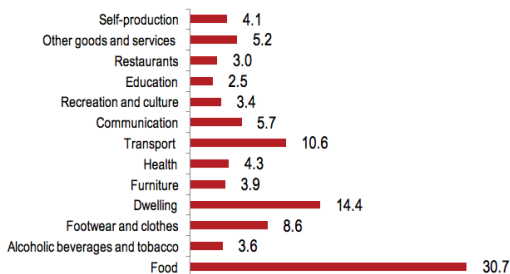

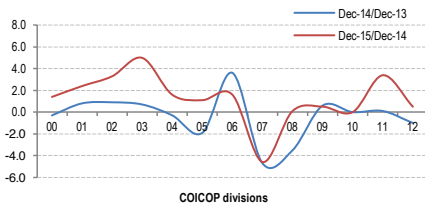
