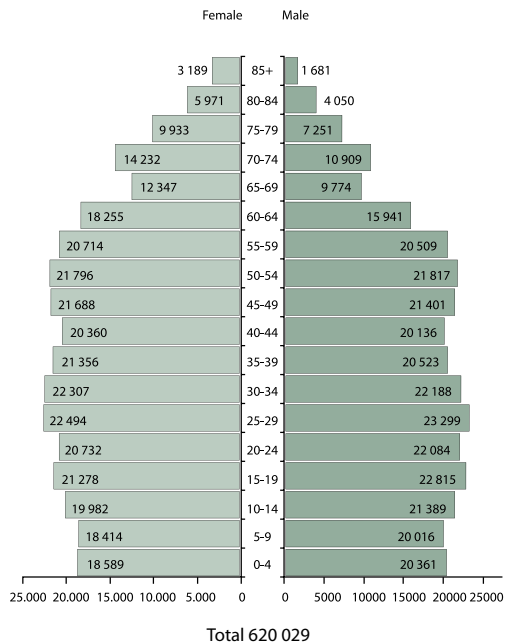

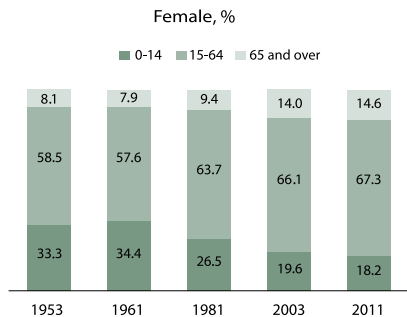
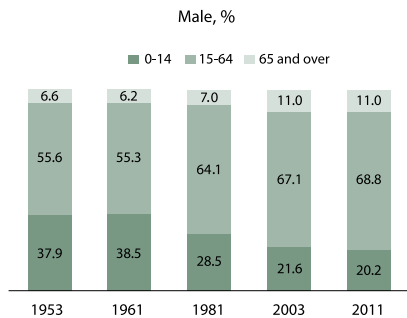

Population by age group and sex, Census 2011



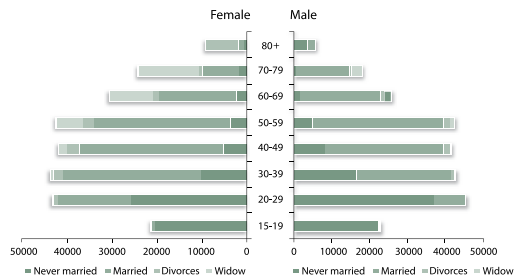
Population by age group, Censuses

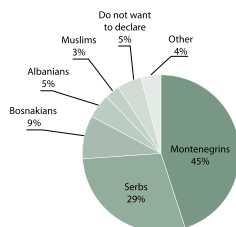

Population aged 15 and over by marital status, Census 2011

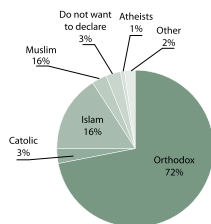

Ethnic structure, Census 2011



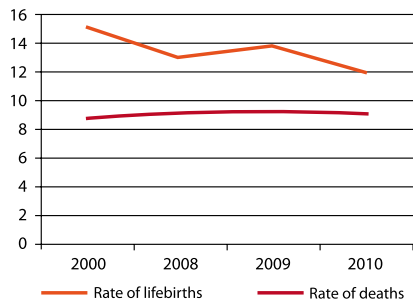
Religion structure, Census 2011



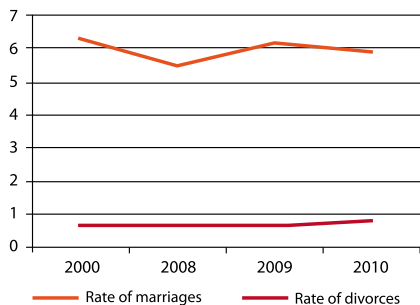

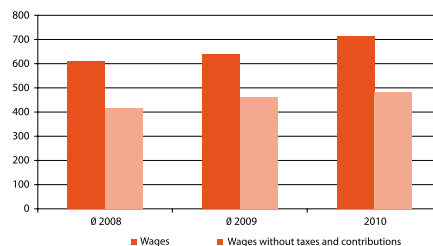

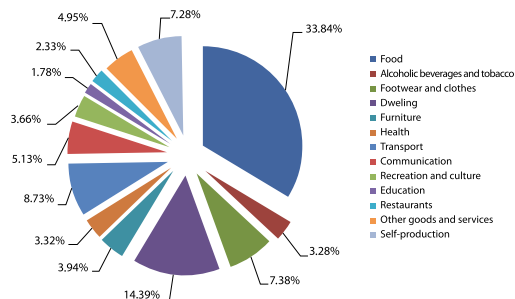
