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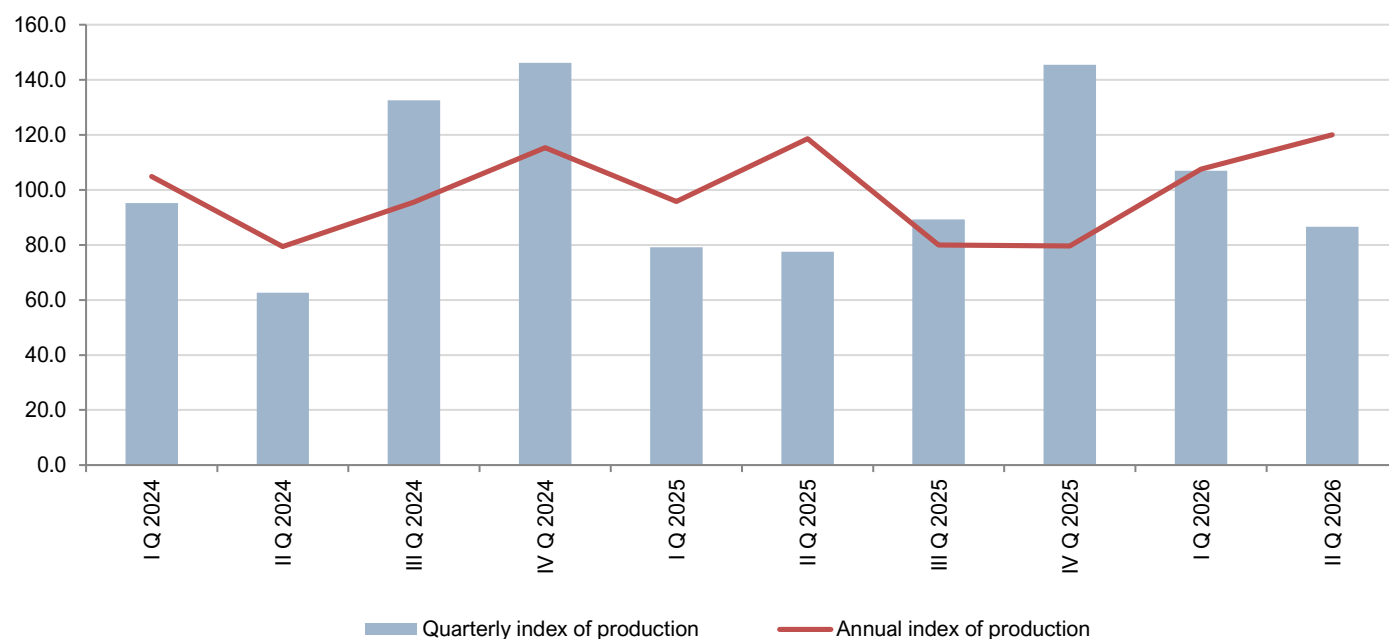
Indices of industrial production and turnover

Second quarter 2026

Industrial production in Montenegro in II quarter 2026 compared with II quarter 2025 increased by 20.0%. At the sector level, compared to II quarter 2025, Mining and quarrying increased by 28.2%, the Manufacturing increased by 2.5% while the Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply increased by 95.4%.

Industrial production in Montenegro in II quarter 2026 compared with I quarter 2026 decreased by 13.4%. At the sector level, compared to I quarter 2026, Mining and quarrying decreased by 1.8%, the Manufacturing increased by 28.0% and the Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply decreased by 52.0%.

Industrial turnover index in Montenegro in II quarter 2026 increased 17.5% compared to II quarter 2025, while increased 29.5% compared to I quarter 2026.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

Industrial production and turnover indices are one of the most important short-term indicators and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Industrial survey is harmonized with EU Regulation 2019/2152 and Regulation 2020/1197 and the concepts and definition used in this survey are in line with these regulations. Survey provides the data on industrial production and turnover in industry.

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units for industrial production indices are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B, C and D of Activity Classification), while for calculate industrial turnover indices are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B and C of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification, and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.

Quantities of finished products covered by sections B, C and D of Activity Classification are used for calculation of industrial production index-total. Turnovers in sections B and C of Activity Classification are used for calculation of industrial turnover index-total, according mentioned EU Regulations.

Data are published according to the [Statistical Release Calendar](#).

The last published data are considered preliminary, and becomes final within the defined deadline, as foreseen by the Statistical Release Calendar.
