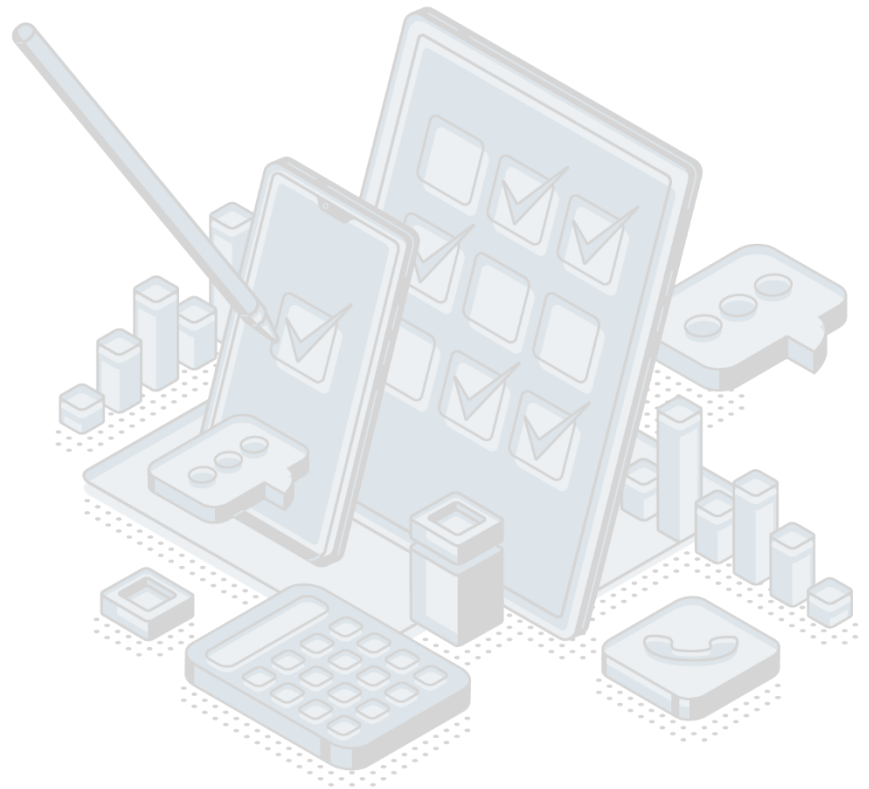

The CBCG collects and statistically processes data pursuant to the Central Bank of Montenegro Law (OGM 4010, 4610, 613, 7017), the Law on Financial Leasing, Factoring, Purchase of Receivables, Micro-lending, and Credit-Guarantee Operations (OGM 7317, 4420), and the Decision on Reports to be Submitted to the Central Bank of Montenegro (OGM 2418).
