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The 2023 Census of Population, Households and Dwellings

Population of Montenegro by foreign languages knowledge

Data in this release relate to the knowledge of foreign languages that is defined as an ability of a person to understand, speak, read, and write a foreign language. Data are collected on the knowledge of a maximum of three foreign languages.

All data are received only based on the declaration of a person who provided the data.

The knowledge of foreign languages is presented for population aged 15 and more, and that is 511 189 inhabitants, of which 262 653 are women, and 248 536 are men.

Data presented in this release relate to foreign languages known by over 1% of population, and there are English, Russian, Italian, German, French, and Spanish.

In Montenegro number of population aged 15 and over that speak some foreign language is 229 558, one foreign language speak 164 180 persons, two foreign languages 53 261, and three and over foreign languages speak 12 117 persons.

The highest percentage of population has the knowledge of English language, i.e. 37.97% out of the total number of population aged 15 and over; knowledge of Russian language is possessed by 7.46%; Italian 4.83%; German 3.72%; French 2.01%, and knowledge of Spanish language is possessed by 1.02% of population aged 15 and over.

Share of population with the knowledge of English language is highest in coastal municipalities, in Budva 54.06%; Kotor 54.05%; Tivat 51.15%; Herceg Novi 47.02%, and in Podgorica 46.83%. The lowest share of English language knowledge is in Petnjica – 13.74%; Pluzine 16.37%, and Savnik 17.54%.

The highest percentage of the knowledge of Russian language is recorded in Zabljak – 18.27%; Mojkovac 15.67%; Savnik 15.43%; Pluzine 14.51%, and in Kolasin 13.25%, while the least percentage is in Gusinje – 1.17% Ulcinj 1.57%, Tuzi 1.79%, and in Rozaje 2.17%.

Italian language is in the highest percentage known in Kotor - 14.88%, than in Cetinje 9.42%, Tivat - 9.04%, Herceg Novi 7.70% and in Bar 6.76%.

The highest percentage of German language knowledge is in Ulcinj – 12.12%, than in Petnjica 9.05%. Rozaje 8.54, Budva 6.36% and in Berane 5.87%.

French language is mostly known in Petnjica – 4.57%, than in Kolasin 2.92%, Tivat 2.91%, Cetinje 2.75% and Budva 2.67%, while Spanish language is mostly known in Kotor – 2.44%, Bar 1.57%, Budva 1.53%, than in Podgorica 1.48% and in Cetinje – 1.39%.

Observed by sex, females have a higher percentage of knowledge in almost all of the listed foreign languages, except German language, where males are more represented, with 53.62% compared to 46.38% in favor of males. The greatest dominance of females is in the knowledge of French (61.46% to 38.54%) and Spanish (65.69% to 34.31%).









METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The Census of Population, Households and Dwellings was implemented in period from 3 to 30 December 2023, in line with the Methodology for Preparation, Organization and Implementation of the Census. The 2023 Census Methodology is in line with the international standards which determine common rules for collecting the data on population, out which the most important are:

• Conference of European Statisticians Recommendations for the 2020 Censuses of Population and Housing prepared by UNECE;

• Regulation No 763/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 July 2008 on population and housing censuses, as well as other implementation regulations with the respect of the European Statistics Code of Practise.

The Census was implemented according to the situation as on 31 October 2023, at midnight, which is considered to be the reference moment of the census.

The census was done in the traditional manner, by the interview method, using paper questionnaires, 'door-to-door' approach.

The release of the census results is defined by Article 30 of the Law on Census.

Population shall include persons with their usual place of residence in Montenegro.

Usual place of residence shall mean a place where a person usually spends the day, regardless of temporary absence due to recreation, vacation, visiting friends or relatives, business absence, as well as the absence due to treatment or religious pilgrimage, as well as a place where the person stays uninterruptedly, at least one year before the Census reference moment or who has arrived at the usual place of residence in the course of 12 months prior the Census reference moment with the intention of staying there for at least one year.

Knowledge of foreign languages is defined as ability of person to understand, speak, read and write some foreign language. Data are collected for three foreign languages the most.

All data are received exclusively on declaration of a person who provided the data.

Common term "Municipality" is used in this release for 25 local self-government units, for the capital Podgorica, royal capital Cetinje and the reminded 23 local self-government units with the status of municipality.

Pursuant to the Law on Official Statistics and Official Statistical System, Article 54-61 (Official Gazette of Montenegro No 018/12 of 30 March 2012, 047/19 of 12 August 2019), and internal rule of Statistical Office, the data with frequency of occurrence less than 10 are protected (primary protection) and they are marked with "z". Additionally, other data are marked and protected with the same sign to prevent an indirect recognition of census units (secondary protection).
