STATISTICAL OFFICE HOSTS REGIONAL STUDY VISIT ON THE AGRICULTURAL CENSUS

Statistical Office of Montenegro hosted a three-day study visit from 3 to 5 March 2026, dedicated to the implementation of the Agricultural Census. During this visit, representatives of statistical institutions from Bosnia and Herzegovina had the opportunity to learn about Montenegro's experience in planning, organizing, and conducting this complex statistical survey.

During the study visit, Montenegro's experiences in preparing and implementing the Agricultural Census were presented, including the legal framework, methodology, organization of fieldwork, and establishment of the census frame. Special focus was placed on the use of modern technological solutions in statistical practice, such as the CAPI system for data collection, as well as data processing procedures, quality control, and data validation.

The study visit is of multiple significance for the statistical institutions of Bosnia and Herzegovina, as it enables direct insight into the practical experiences and solutions applied in Montenegro, which may contribute to a more efficient preparation and implementation of the Agricultural Census in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

At the same time, this activity represents an opportunity to further strengthen regional cooperation among statistical institutions, exchange knowledge and best practices, and confirm the professional capacities of the Statistical Office of Montenegro in conducting complex statistical surveys.

The implementation of the Agricultural Census is also of particular importance in the context of the European integration process, as high-quality and internationally comparable statistical data represent an important segment of alignment with the EU acquis under Chapter 18 – Statistics, as well as an important basis for policymaking in the field of agriculture and rural development.
