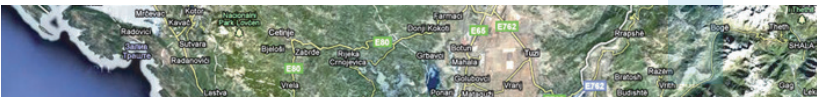

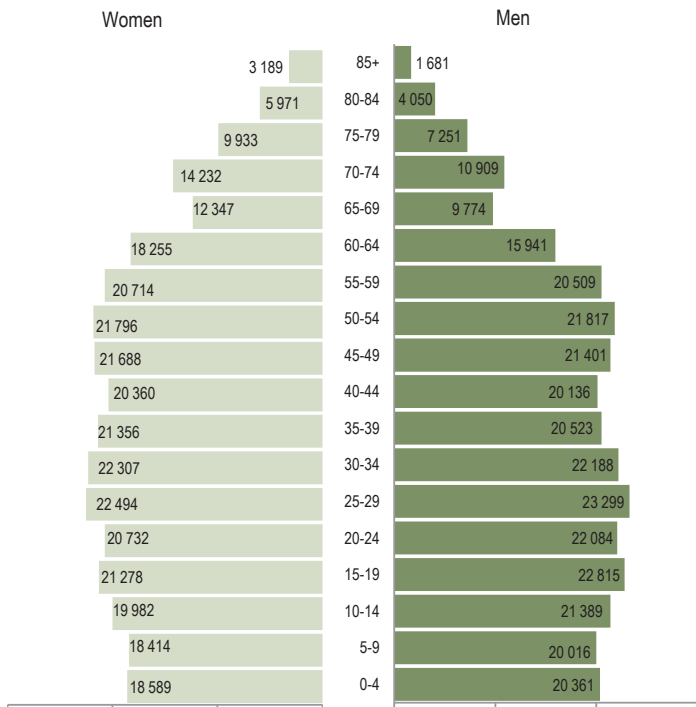

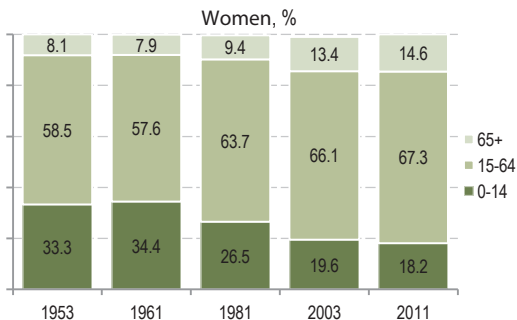
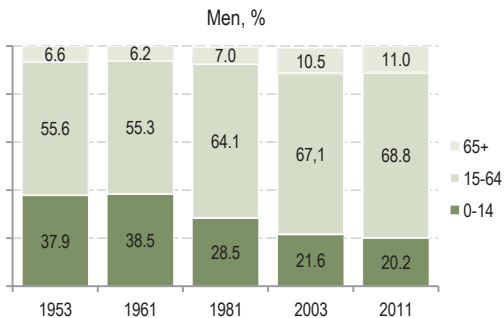

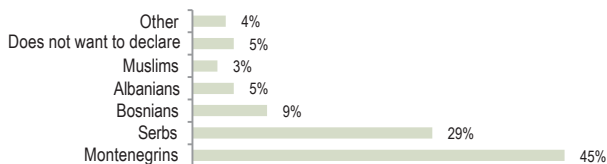
Population aged 15 and over, by marital status, Census 2011



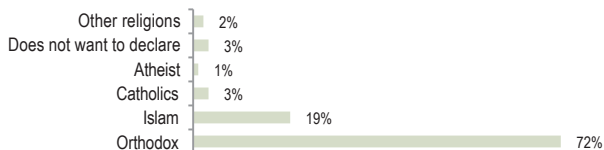

National, i.e. ethnic structure, Census 2011



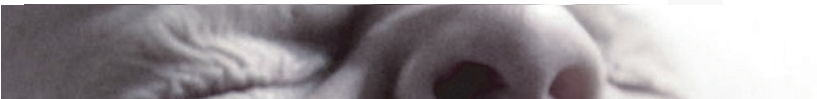
Religion structure, Census 2011



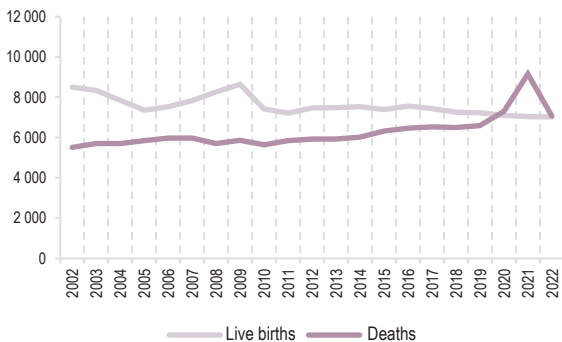

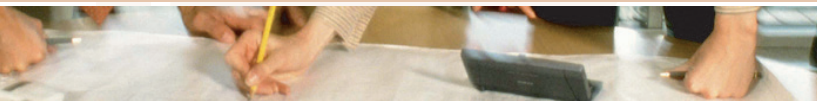

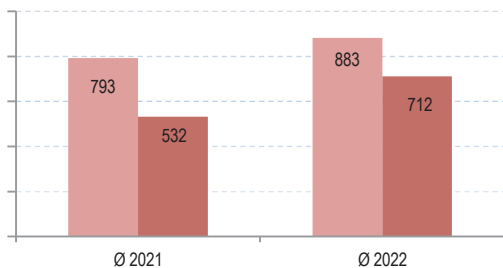

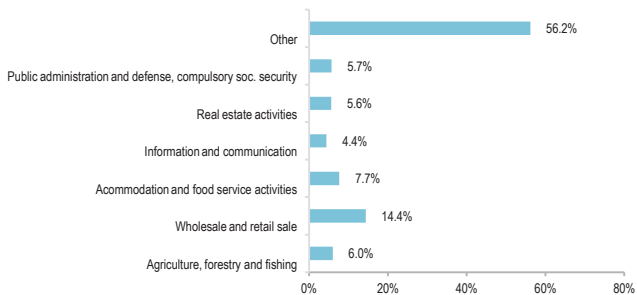

Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2021



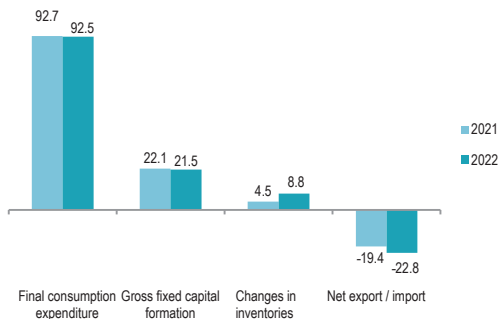
Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2022

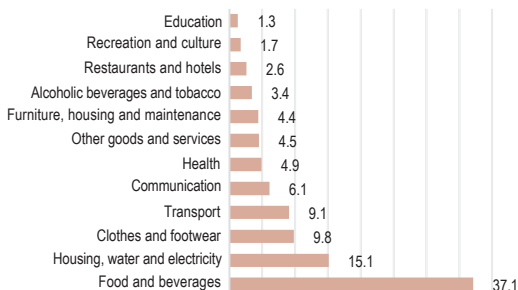
Structure of GDP by type of expenditure at current prices, 2021 and 2022

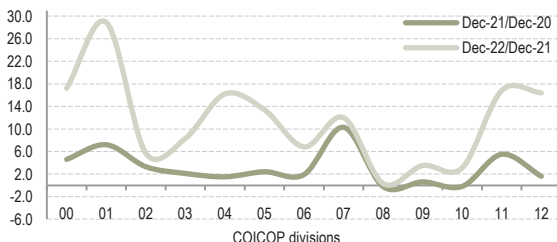
Structure of total personal consumption in 2021, Montenegro

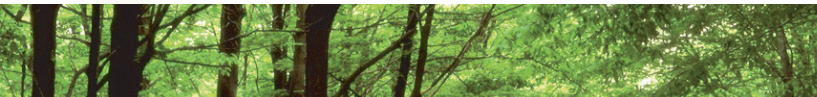
