





Men, %







#### Population aged 15 and over, by marital status, Census 2023



#### National, i.e. ethnic structure, Census 2023







#### Structure of GDP by activities at current prices, 2022




#### Structure of GDP by type of expenditure at current prices, 2022 and 2023






