## Average earnings (wages)

## October 2023

The average earnings (gross) in Montenegro in October 2023 are 1 002 Euro, while the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) are 803 Euro. The average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in October 2023 comparing to September 2023 increased for 0.4%, while the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in October 2023 comparing to the same month of the previous year increased for 11.5%.

Having in mind that consumer prices in October 2023 comparing to September 2023 decreased for 0.3%, the results is that real earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in the same period increased for 0.7%.

At the sector level, the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in October 2023 compared to September 2023 increased in the following sectors: Transportation and storage (2.3%), Administrative and support service activities (1.6%), Construction (1.2%), Education (1.0%), Information and communication (0.8%), Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (0.4%), Human health and social work activities (0.3%), Mining and quarrying (0.2%), Financial and insurance activities (0.2%), Accommodation and food service activities (0.1%) and Professional, scientific and technical activities (0.1%).

There was a decrease in the following sectors: Real estate activities (3.5%), Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (1.8%), Arts, entertainment and recreation (1.3%), Agriculture, forestry and fishing (1.2%), Manufacturing (0.8%), Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (0.4%), Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (0.2%) and Other service activities (0.1%).

## **METHODOLOGICAL NOTES**

The data on average monthly earnings present earnings paid within a month, and they are received by the regular monthly survey Monthly report on employees and earnings (RAD-1 form).

The average earnings (gross) are calculated dividing the total earnings paid off in a month by the number of number of employees the paid earnings refer to. Earnings without taxes and contributions (net) comprise earnings (gross) reduced by taxes and contributions paid by employee.

The index on real average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) represent the ratio between index on nominal average earnings without taxes and contributions (net), and consumer price index.
