Average earnings (wages)

May 2024

The average earnings (gross) in Montenegro in May 2024 are 1042 Euro, while the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) are 832 Euro. The average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in May 2024 comparing to April 2024 increased for 0.5%, while the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in May 2024 comparing to the same month of the previous year increased for 4.9%.

Having in mind that consumer prices in May 2024 comparing to April 2024 increased for 0.1% the results is that real earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in the same period increased for 0.4%.





At the sector level, the average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) in May 2024 compared to April 2024 increased in the following sectors: Accommodation and food service activities (2.0%), Water supply, sewerage, waste management and remediation activities (1.5%), Administrative and support service activities (1.5%), Human health and social work activities (1.3%), Manufacturing (1.2%), Arts, entertainment and recreation (1.1%), Construction (1.0%), Transportation and storage (1.0%), Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply (0.8%), Wholesale and retail trade and repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles (0.7%), Information and communication (0.6%) and Agriculture, forestry and fishing (0.1%).

There was a decrease in the following sectors: Financial and insurance activities (1.7%), Real estate activities (0.3%), Mining and quarrying (0.2%), Professional, scientific and technical activities (0.1%), Public administration and defence; compulsory social security (0.1%), Education (0.1%) and Other service activities (0.1%).

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The data on average monthly earnings present earnings paid within a month, and they are received by the regular monthly survey Monthly report on employees and earnings (RAD-1 form).

The average earnings (gross) are calculated dividing the total earnings paid off in a month by the number of number of employees the paid earnings refer to. Earnings without taxes and contributions (net) comprise earnings (gross) reduced by taxes and contributions paid by employee.

The index on real average earnings without taxes and contributions (net) represent the ratio between index on nominal average earnings without taxes and contributions (net), and consumer price index.
