In 2016 there were demolished 24 dwellings, 20 dwellings are demolished because of construction of new buildings, while 4 dwellings are demolished because of worn out condition.

Graph 1. Number of demolished dwellings

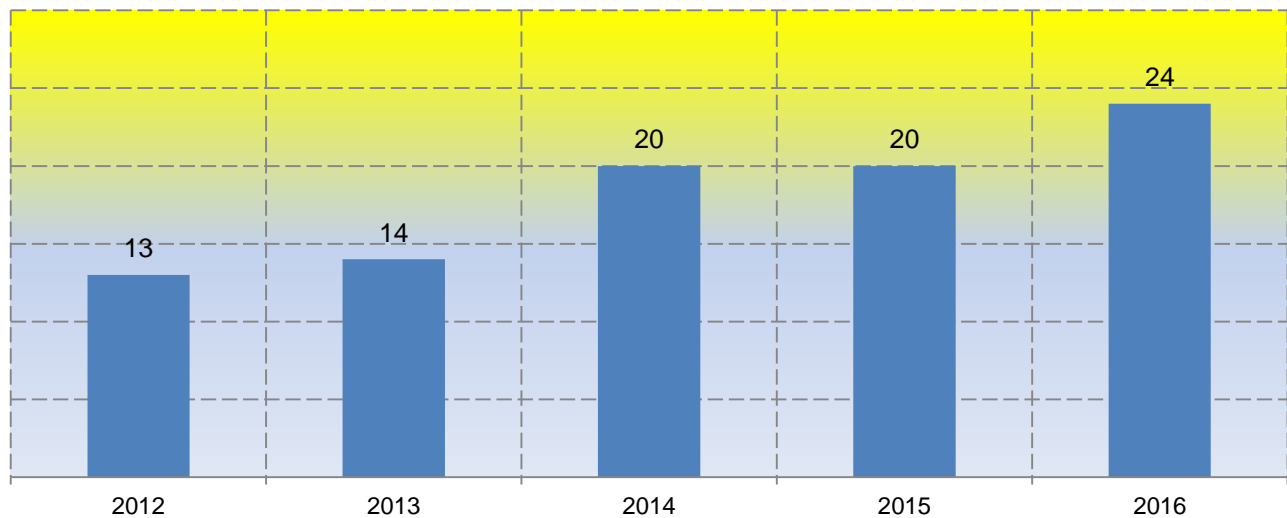

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Source of data and coverage

Annual report on torn out buildings with dwellings and adaptation of residential areas (GRAD-71), is filled in by Administration for inspection affairs and competent bodies of public administration.

This report shall be filled only for entirely demolished building containing one or more completed dwellings. Therefore, do not be include damaged buildings and houses which are to be repaired or demolished buildings where not completed a single dwelling.

Definition

The report covers each demolished building where there was one or more dwellings, then buildings where there was change of purpose of residential premise into non-residential area or joining two or more dwellings into one dwelling.

Demolished dwellings are dwellings which were dedicated for permanent living in and the reason of demolishing is because of:

- The age of the facility and building of new facilities;
- Construction without permits, (for example, there are not included non-legally built buildings if in the moment of tearing down none of the dwellings was not completed);
- Elemental force such as earthquake, avalanche, flood, fire, etc.;
- Worn out condition, non-hygienic conditions of living in, land -slide;
- Because of adaptation of residential into non-residential, that is in the case when in the building there was change of the purpose of one or more dwellings into non - residential;
- Other is for the cases when in the building there was constructed two or more dwellings into one dwelling.
