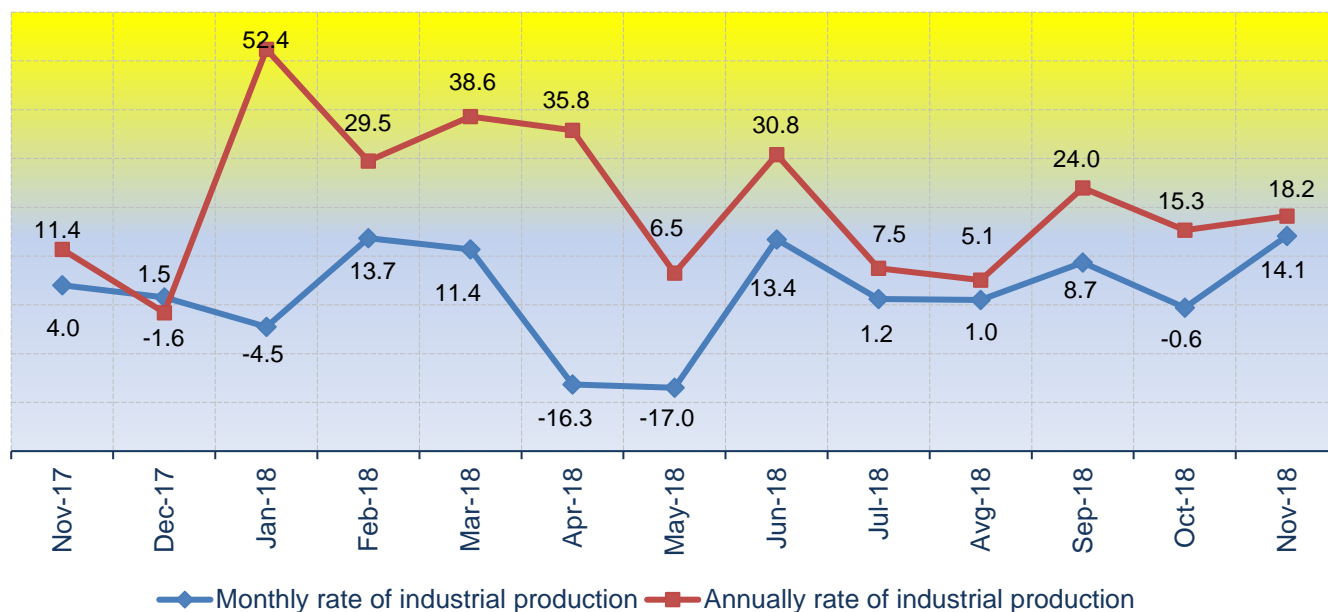


## Indices of industrial production and turnover November 2018<sup>(p)</sup>

Industrial production in Montenegro in November 2018 increased 18.2% compared to same month of previous year.

In the period January-November 2018 compared to the same period of the previous year, the industrial production index increased by 22.8%. In the observed period, the Electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply recorded significant growth of 70.2% and the manufacturing increased by 10.1%, while the mining and quarrying decreased by 21.6%.

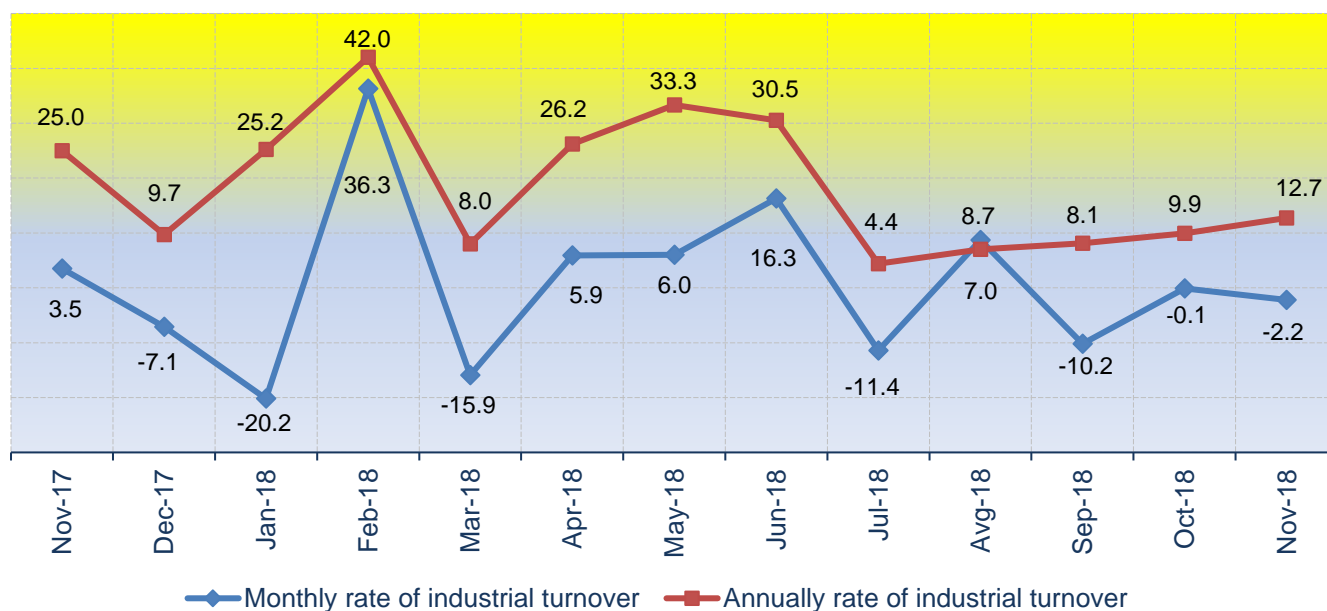

Industrial turnover in Montenegro in November 2018 increased 12.7% compared with the same month of previous year.

At the sector level, compared with the same month of previous year, there was a increase of turnover in manufacturing 10.8%, as well as in mining and quarrying 20.2%.

## METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATION

### Data source, coverage and definitions

Industrial production and turnover indices are one of the most important short-term indicators and a basis for decision making in the area of economy.

Monthly survey on industrial production is harmonised with EU Regulation 1165/98 and Regulation 1502/2006 and the concepts and definition used in this survey are in line with these regulations. Survey provides the data on industrial production (quantity of products produced in the reporting month, from beginning to the end of reporting month, quantities of final products in stocks, sale of final products from beginning to the end of reporting month, value of production in reporting month, number of workers, gross earnings of employees, number of hours worked, value of stock, profit from sale - turnover).

Statistical Business Register (SBR) is used as the frame for the coverage for the purposes of this survey. Reporting units for industrial production indices are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B, C and D of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification, and they satisfy the criteria for this survey. Reporting units for industrial turnover indices are businesses engaged in the industrial production (sectors B and C of Activity Classification), as well as parts of commercial businesses classified into other sectors of Activity Classification, and they satisfy the criteria for this survey.

Quantities of finished products covered by sections B, C and D of Activity Classification are used for calculation of industrial production index-total. Turnovers in sections B and C of Activity Classification are used for calculation of industrial turnover index-total, according mentioned EU Regulations.

The data are published according Data publishing calendar, as well as in our website [www.monstat.org](http://www.monstat.org).

The last published data are considered preliminary, and becomes final within the defined deadline, as foreseen by the Statistical Release Calendar.
