

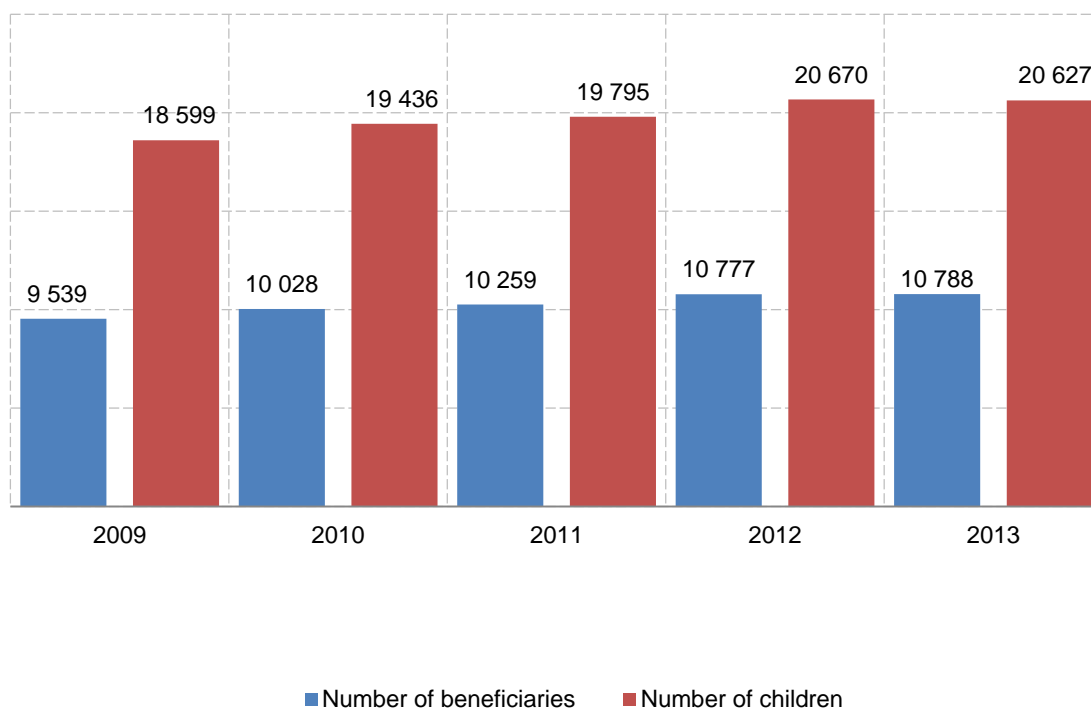
Child support beneficiaries in 2013

Total number of beneficiaries realising the right to child support in 2013 was 10 788, and number of children realising the right to child support in the same year was 20 627. Out of that number, 104 children in institutions for children without parental care are beneficiaries of child support.

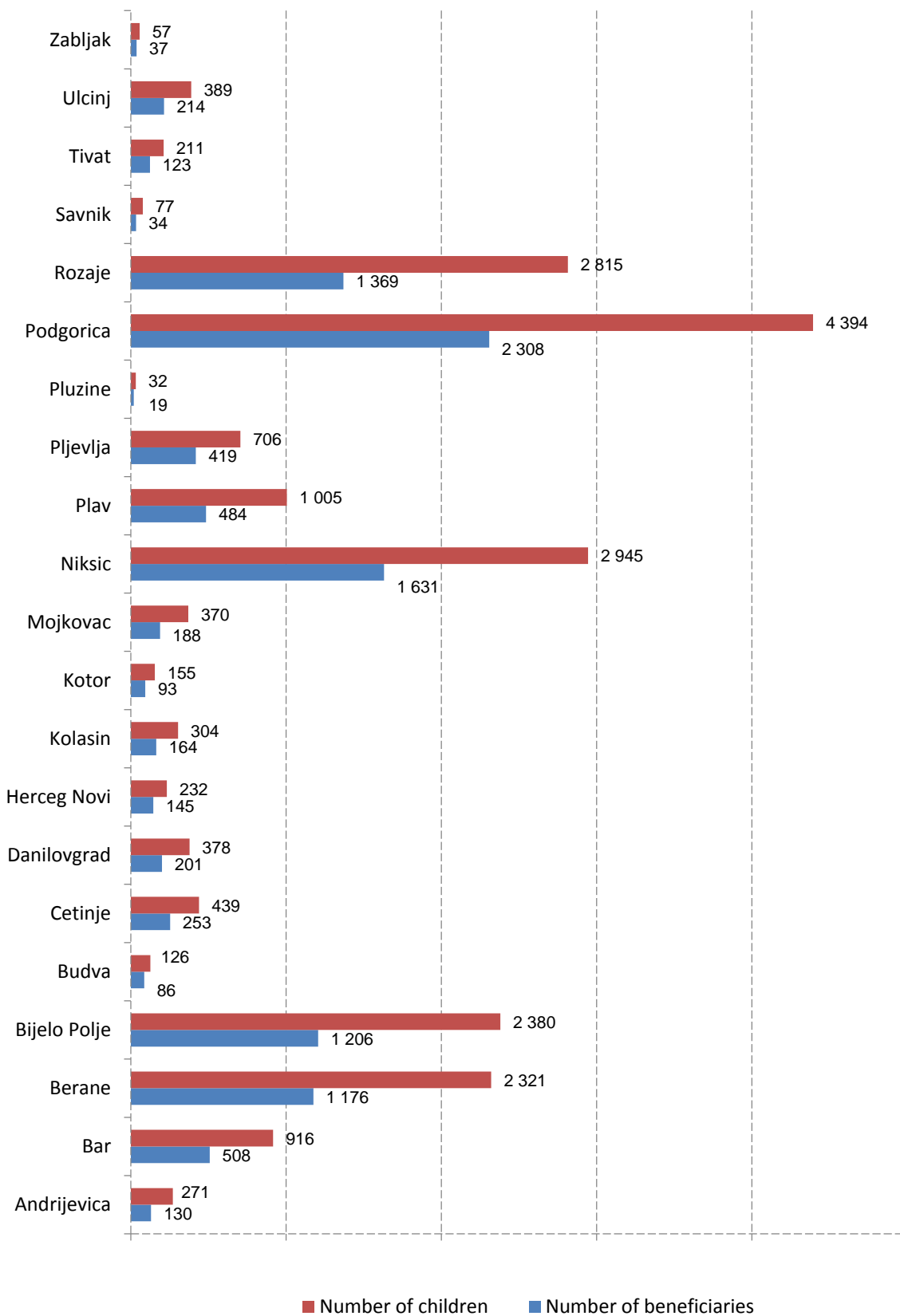
Compared to 2012. godinu, number of beneficiaries realising the right to child support increased by 0.1%, and number of children beneficiaries decreased by 0.2% in 2013.

The total amount paid for year 2013 amount to 4 961 757€, which is an increase of 0.7%, comparing to previous year. The largest share in total assets belong to Podgorica, 1 061 895 or 21.4%, while the least funds are paid to the municipality Plužine 7 415 or 0.1%.

METHODOLOGICAL EXPLANATIONS

Data in this Release were obtained through the annual report of Ministry of Labour and Social Welfare of Montenegro, and refer to number of beneficiaries, number of children realising the right to child support and disbursed funds.

Data refer to the average number of holders of rights to child allowance and the average number of children using child benefits. Funds paid on annual basis.

According to the Law on Social and Child Protection entitled to child benefit can be achieved:

- Child allowance beneficiaries;*
- A child with a physical, mental or sensory disability, who can be trained to live and work independently;*
- A child with a physical, mental or sensory disability, which can not be trained for independent life and work;*
- Children without parental care.*

The child allowance is paid in a monthly amount to the parent or guardian or the person from whom the child was entrusted to the care, education and training.

Allowance for a child without parental care, which is placed in an institution, shall be paid on behalf of a child to an authorized person at the facility and is used for the needs of the child.
