



Municipal waste in Montenegro 2013

The release comprises selected statistical data on the quantity of collected municipal waste, equipment and machinery in 2013.

In Montenegro, collected 286 378 tons of waste including the subgroup 1501 – Packaging (including separately collected municipal waste in packaging) in 2013. Taking into account the estimated the number of inhabitants 1 January 2013, were collected 1.26 kg waste per capita in the 2013 year, which is 2.4% more compared to the 2012 year when he collected 1.23 kg waste per capita.

In 2013, 77.3% of the Montenegrin population used the services of public utilities in municipal waste.

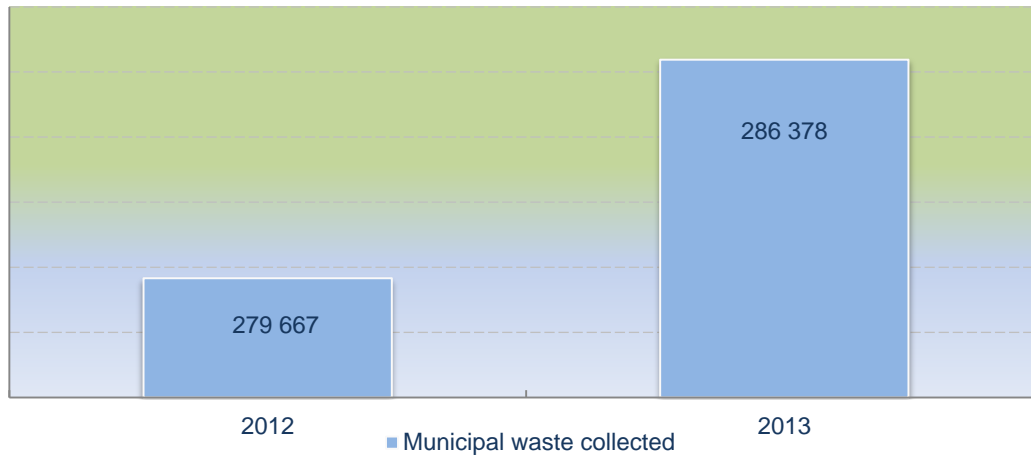
Total full-time employment in utilities to the Registry for the local government granted permission to perform the public service of collection and disposal of municipal waste in 2013 was 2 206 employees.

Compared with the 2012 year, for 1 day increased the average number of days in which the collected waste the in 2013 year.

Total quantities of municipal waste generated in 2013 were 286 378 tonnes, as compared with 2012 increased by 2.4%.

METHODOLOGICAL NOTES

The release on waste collection by municipalities is submitted by using the reporting method at the annual level, with the data on municipal waste, mainly provided on the estimation basis. The aim of the Annual report on waste in municipalities produce reliable data on the public collection and separation of waste by municipalities, the source of collected waste and the treatment of waste collected.

The reporting units are public utility enterprises, i.e. enterprises with the main activity of cleaning and maintaining public areas in town to which the Secretariat for Local Government issued a permit for performance public service of communal waste collection and transportation, and they perform this activity on the whole territory of Montenegro.

Waste is any substance or subject that the holder discarded or intends to discard it in compliance with the Law (Law on Waste Management, Official Gazette of Montenegro 64/11 as of 29 November 2011).

Municipal waste is the waste that appeared in households or during operations which are similar by their characteristics to the waste appeared in households.

Mixed municipal waste is the waste from the household left after separation of some municipal waste fractions for which the possibility of selective collection is envisaged.

Waste collection is the waste collecting from the holder including previous classification and temporary waste storage for the needs of transportation to the waste processing facilities.
